**Global Rank (TNC and ABI ranks):**

Species have both a Global Rank (G) (or Trinomial Rank (T) for subspecies). The numeric ranks describe the status of the species: 1 = the species (or trinomial) is globally critically imperiled, 2 = the species (or trinomial) is globally nationally imperiled; 3 = the species (or trinomial) is either rare or uncommon; 4 = the species (or trinomial) is globally widespread, abundant, or apparently secure, but with cause for long-term concern; 5 = the species (or trinomial) is globally demonstrably widespread, abundant, and secure.

In addition to or in place of the numeric rank, the Global (G) or Trinomial (T), Rank can have one of the following descriptive qualifiers: ? = the species (or trinomial) is either unranked or has a questionable rank; U = the species (or trinomial) is unrankable; H = the species (or trinomial) is historic; X = the species (or trinomial) is extinct; Q = the species (or trinomial) has questionable taxonomy according to TNC and ABI scientists
