

I am listening right now to 89.1, WWFM, a 24-hour Classical Music station broadcasting from Trenton, NJ. This is the only full-time classical station operating in the region between New York and Baltimore. The reception here in Collingswood is not as strong as I would like, but I have purchased an antenna to help. I am deeply concerned that the proposed licensing of low-power FM stations will have a negative effect on WWFM. In particular, I feel that someone may decide that 89.1 is not being used here in Collingswood, and a low-power radio at that frequency (or an adjacent one) would be started, smothering WWFM reception.
