Pasadena. **GAMBLE HOUSE** (**GREENE AND GREENE LIBRARY**), 4 Westmoreland 1908, Greene and Greene, architects. Frame, shingling, 2 1/2 stories over basement, modified rectangle, low gabled roof sections with projecting rafters and balconies with slat rails brace or stilt supports, interiors with variety woods, fine staircase, pegged and wedged construction techniques, and complete furnishings from the architects' designs; landscaped garage and servants' building. Western Stick Style. Perhaps the most complete and best-preserved house by noted architects, Charles and Henry Greene, whose work in CA illustrated the development of a regional style while epitomizing much of the arts and crafts movement.
