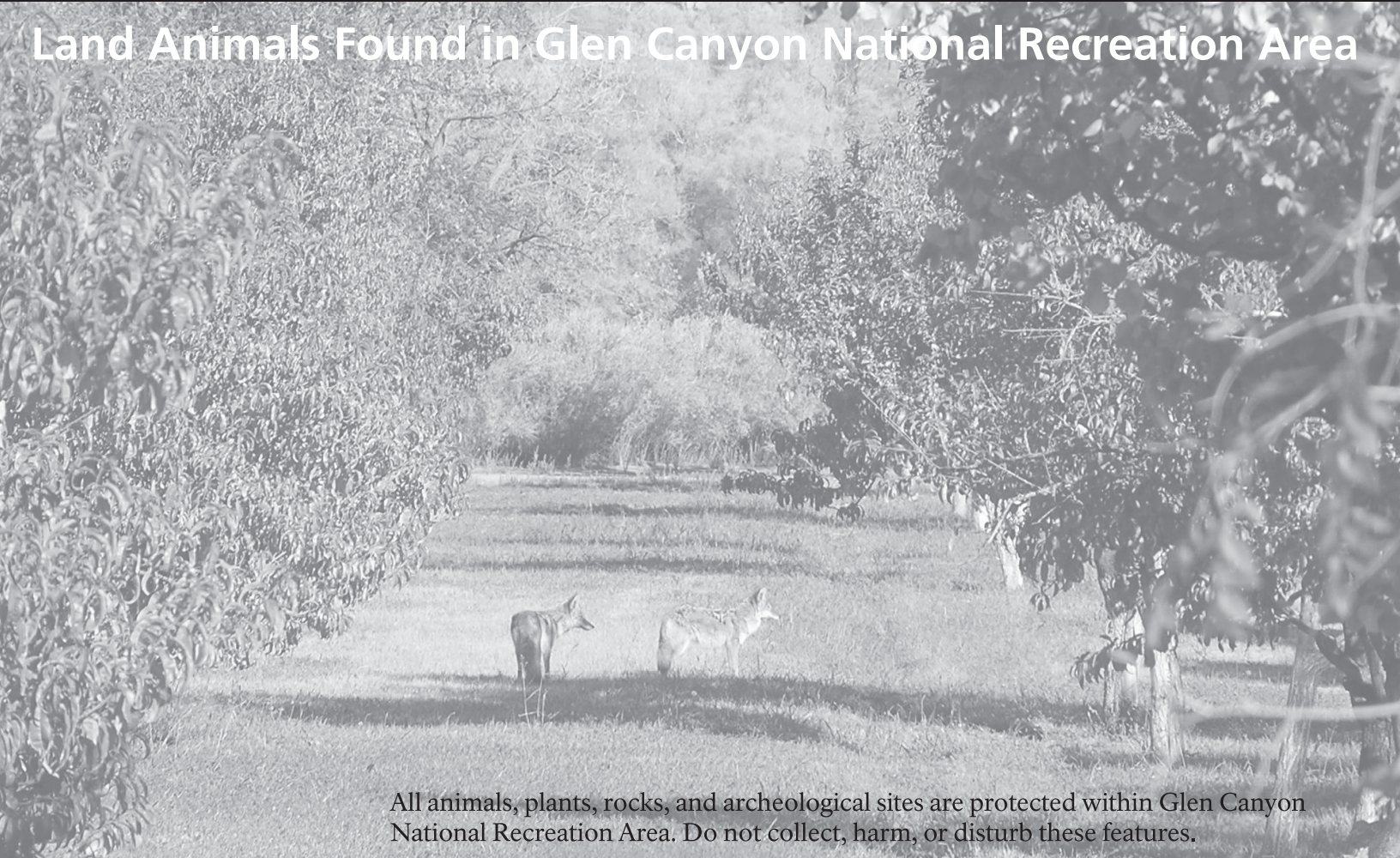




Land Animals Found in Glen Canyon National Recreation Area
