



Uncompahgre Field Office Field Office-Wide Travel Management Plan Amendment Information Sheet

The Uncompahgre Field Office is proposing to:

Change motorized travel designations in the Uncompahgre Field Office Area from “Open” to “Limited to Existing Routes.” In addition, a comprehensive travel management plan establishing a transportation system of designated roads and trails within the Dry Creek area on the east side of the Uncompahgre Plateau is being proposed.

The proposed action **does not** affect:

- Travel decisions in the Gunnison Gorge National Conservation Area RMP, which was signed in 2004.
- North Delta OHV Play Area which will be addressed in subsequent travel management planning.
- Gunnison Travel Interim Restrictions Plan Amendment area which will be addressed in subsequent travel management planning.
- Other designations such as “Limited to Existing” and “Limited to Designated” areas in the RMPs. These areas will be addressed in subsequent travel management planning.
