# NOISE AS IDENTIFIED IN THE TEXTS OF INSTRUMENTS

- 1992 Helsinki Convention for the Protection of the Baltic
  - Article 9 noise is narrowly confined to a problem associated with pleasure boats
  - 1991 Arctic Environmental Protection Strategy
    - Noise is broadly identified as one of 6 environmental concerns in the Arctic
- 1992 ASCOBANS
  - Noise is noted as a potential source of disturbance to populations of small cetaceans.
