On behalf of Heifer Vietnam, we wish to thank you for supporting our program through your Operation Day's Work activities. Your generosity will enable a new project to be developed in An Giang Province in the Mekong Delta. This project will provide education and livestock to very poor teenage girls to prevent them from being victims of child trafficking. The Vietnam Youth at Risk project will enable these girls to attend a special program for vulnerable youth at Cantho University to learn reading and arithmetic. They will also learn to care for livestock, a valuable skill they can share with their families. When they leave, every girl will be given two heifers and a micro-loan to start a vegetable garden. These assets will benefit her family and help her become a productive member of her community.

As a donor, you will also enable these young women to become donors to other poor teens in their community. Through Heifer International's program of "Passing on the Gift," each girl will give her cow's first born heifer to another girl in need in her village. In this way, your original contribution will be multiplied throughout the community.

We appreciate your concern for the plight of teenagers on the other side of the world. We look forward to reporting our progress as the girls begin their program.
