AMERICA THE BEAUTIFUL SENIOR PASS

Duration: Lifetime Pass

Cost: \$10.00

Available to: U.S. citizens or permanent residents age 62 or over

Provides admission to: Federal recreation sites that charge an Entrance Fee or Standard Amenity Fee.

Provides admission for: the pass holder and passengers in a non-commercial vehicle at per vehicle fee areas, and the pass holder + 3 adults, at per-person fee areas (children under 16 are admitted free).

How to obtain a senior pass: Apply in person with proof of your age <u>and U.S.</u> <u>citizenship</u> at any participating federal recreation site or office. Note: A state driver's license does not constitute proof of U.S. citizenship. (<u>learn why</u>). The following are examples of acceptable documents which can be used to establish U.S. citizenship:

- Social Security card (not merely your SS number)
- Medicare card
- Voter registration card
- U.S. Passport
- Birth certificate
- Concealed Weapons Permit
- Retired Military ID card (DD Form 2)

Contrary to popular belief, you do not have to buy this pass before you set out on your trip. Any national park or federal recreation site charging an entrance fee can sell you an America the Beautiful Senior Pass.
