# Yahoo! and Law Enforcement

#### Areas in which Yahoo! cooperates with Law Enforcement

- Violent crimes (e.g. murder, kidnapping)
- Terrorism and USA PATRIOT Act violations
- Child pornography and online sexual predators
- Fraud (e.g. auction fraud, phishing), spam, identity theft
- Intellectual property infringement and theft of trade secrets
- Who is investigating?
  - federal law enforcement agencies (DOJ, FBI, DEA, Customs, Secret Service, Postal, military investigative agencies)
  - federal agencies with civil enforcement powers (SEC, FTC, Commerce)
  - state law enforcement, attorney general offices, and state agencies (e.g. Family Services)
  - local police in 50 states





### Yahoo! changes in response to 9/11

- Yahoo! voluntarily implemented changes to assist law enforcement following 9/11
  - Restructure of tools and systems for USA PATRIOT Act changes and law enforcement needs.
  - Re-organization of team dedicated to handling national security requests.
  - 24 x 7 availability via three pagers to handle emergency requests from law enforcement.
  - Increase in staff of case assistants.





# How Yahoo! supports Law Enforcement

- Staff of 15 full-time employees to respond to law enforcement requests
- Accepts service of law enforcement process by fax
- Dedicated telephone line for law enforcement calls
- Emergency availability 24 x 7
- Specialized team with security clearances to handle national security requests
- Provides witnesses for trial testimony





 Yahoo! has played a significant role in federal and state criminal investigations and prosecutions.
