Marketing Campaign on Google, Yahoo!, and WebMD for the CDC Breast Cancer Web Site – 2006

## FINAL REPORT

February 9, 2007

### Overview

A 6-week, Web-based marketing campaign was conducted for the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), Division of Cancer Prevention and Control's (DCPC) new breast cancer Web site. The campaign was timed to coincide with the United States' National Breast Cancer Awareness Month (October). The campaign goals were to promote the CDC's new breast cancer Web site, which went live on September 28, 2006, and to drive traffic to the site where people could:

- learn about early detection and screening (including mammography),
- find local resources for free and low cost mammography services, and
- learn about breast cancer statistics that are available through CDC.

The campaign involved keyword marketing on Google and Yahoo! and a banner ad on WebMD. The Google campaign was activated by Information Ventures, Inc. (IVI) on Sunday, October 1, 2006. The Yahoo! campaign started on Tuesday, October 3, 2006. Both campaigns were turned off by IVI staff at midnight on Saturday, November 11, 2006. The banner ad campaign on WebMD ran for 1 week starting midnight, Sunday, October 15, 2006 and ending at midnight, Saturday, October 21, 2006. The WebMD campaign involved banner ads on the WebMD site and on WebMD's partner sites.

### Definitions

<u>Keyword marketing</u> is the process of paying search engines like Google and Yahoo! to display an ad related to a search term (keyword) on their search results pages. A *keyword marketing campaign* is composed of a carefully researched set of keywords, prepared ad copy, and destination Web pages for each ad. Web searchers who click on an ad are directed to the associated Web page. Each time an ad is displayed on a search results page, it is considered to be an *impression* and each time an ad is clicked on, it is considered to be a *click-through* to the destination Web page.

A <u>banner ad</u> is a graphical ad displayed on a Web page.

### Methods

Keyword lists and ads customized for Google and Yahoo! were developed by IVI in collaboration with CDC and Northrop Grumman after the new breast cancer Web pages were finalized and campaign goals and campaign target pages were determined. During the process of finalizing the new Web pages, IVI was responsible for developing metatag content for the Web page keywords, titles, and description

elements with input from the Northrop Grumman Web team and CDC subject matter experts. These metatags were used as a starting point for developing the keyword lists and ad copy for the Google and Yahoo! campaigns. The steps followed for identification of keyword metatag content and campaign keyword lists are outlined in Appendix I. To facilitate campaign management, ads and keywords were grouped into topical sets referred to as ad groups; a single ad group has one destination Web page, but multiple ad groups may have the same destination. A list of the final 9 Google ad groups, 5 destination URLs, 29 ads, and 135 keywords is given in Appendix II. The Yahoo! campaign management system does not include ad grouping. The keyword set for Google included misspellings to account for the inaccuracy of search term entry (mamogram, brest, etc.), but the Yahoo! system automatically includes misspellings for each term and thus misspellings were not included in the keyword list for Yahoo! (11 ads and 74 unique keywords for Yahoo!).

Post-campaign reports from Google, Yahoo!, and WebMD were used to document the number of ad impressions, number of clicks (click-through to CDC Web page), and cost per click, with breakdown by ad groups and keywords (Table I & Appendix III). Omniture SiteCatalyst reporting was used post-campaign to evaluate Web site traffic during and after the campaign. Before the campaign, the Web site did not exist in its current form and precampaign Web site traffic data is thus not available. Omniture reports generated for the five target pages were page summaries, referring domains, and next page.

Five specific pages in the new Breast Cancer Web site were targeted as destination pages for the ads:

The budget for the 6-week keyword campaign was \$10,000, split evenly between Google and Yahoo! In addition, the 7-day WebMD banner ad campaign during October had a budget of \$3,000.

# Results

Together, the campaigns on Google and Yahoo! provided 1,658,130 impressions of the various breast cancer related text ads (Fig. I & II; Table I) and 16,123 click-throughs on those ads to the CDC breast cancer Web site (Fig. III, IV, & V). These

totals include impressions and click-throughs from both sponsored searches and content matches on Google and Yahoo! partner sites (Fig. II & IV; Table I). The overall click-through rate (CTR – number clicks per number of impressions) for the Google and Yahoo! ads together was 1 percent. However, certain combinations of keywords and ads (referred to as ad groups in Google) had much higher click-through rates. For example, among those with significant numbers of impressions, "free mammograms" and "breast cancer statistics" had click through rates of 13.8% and 14.6%, respectively (Appendix III).

Google and Yahoo! ads were distributed among their own search results pages (sponsored search), as well as on pages of their content partners such as AOL, New York Times, CNN.com, ask.com, iVillage and other major Web sites (content match). Content partner ads are pushed to users based on general topic matching, not exact keyword matching. Overall, for Google plus Yahoo!, 40% of the impressions were on search results Web pages and 60% of the impressions were on content partner Web sites (Fig. III, IV, & V). The CTR was 2.1% overall for sponsored search results and 0.2 percent for partner content matches (Table I). Note that click throughs on Yahoo! content partner ads were essentially nil (only 99 total) for reasons that remain to be determined.

The 7-day WebMD banner ad campaign added an additional 394 click-throughs from 333,820 banner ad impressions, a CTR of 0.12% (Table II).

Including both the keyword and banner ad campaigns, the campaign garnered 1,991,950 impressions of the ads and 16,517 click-throughs on those ads to the CDC breast cancer Web site. Significantly, almost 2 million people were exposed to text or banner ad messages concerning breast cancer and approximately 1% clicked on the ads and visited DCPC's Breast Cancer Web site (Table I).

As of the end of the campaign, the actual expenditure for Google was \$4,993.38, averaging \$0.47 per click; the actual expenditure for Yahoo! was \$4,281.89, averaging \$0.76 cents per click. Total expenditure for Google and Yahoo! was, therefore, \$9,275.27; or \$724.30 under the planned budget. Including WebMD, the total breast cancer Web site promotion cost was \$12,275.27. Overall, the average cost per click was \$0.57 for the 16,517 clicks received (Table I & Table II; Fig. VII).

Position of the text ads on search result and content partner Web pages is counted from the top of a Web page, where there may be several text ads, then down the right side of a Web page (see Appendices VII and VIII). On Google search results pages, the average position of the ads was 3.6 (essentially at the first position on the right); and on Google content partner pages, the average position was 3.9; the overall position was 3.8 for Google. On Yahoo! search results pages, the average position of the ads was 5 (essentially the second position on the right); and on Yahoo! content partner pages, the average position was 2; the overall average position was 3.7 for Yahoo! (see Table I & Fig. VI).

Individual keywords varied widely in their productivity, that is, in the number of click-throughs for ads associated with each keyword. The most productive keyword in the Google campaign was "breast cancer facts," which accounted for 1,031 of the

10,518 clicks received for all 135 keywords during the Google campaign, or 9.8% of the total. The other top keywords for Google were "free mammograms" (1,016 clicks; 9.7%), "statistics breast cancer" (939 clicks; 8.9%), and "mammogram" (773 clicks; 7.3%). Together, these top four keywords accounted for 35.7% of all click-throughs in the Google campaign. (See Appendix III: Campaign Summary – Google Ad Report and Appendices IV & V: Google Ad Group and Keyword Reports). The most productive keyword of the 74 keywords in the Yahoo! campaign was "breast cancer," which accounted for 2,300 of the 5,605 clicks received for all keywords during the Yahoo! campaign, or 41% of the total. The other top keywords for Yahoo! were "women's health" (873 clicks; 16%), "free mammogram" (594 clicks; 11%), and "mammogram" (571 clicks; 10%). Together, these top four keywords accounted for 77% of all click-throughs in the Yahoo! campaign. (See Appendix VI: Campaign Summary – Yahoo! keyword Report).

When looking at ad groups targeting individual pages (see Tables III & IV), on Google, ads related to breast cancer screening received 255,918 impressions and 5,852 clicks, resulting in a CTR of 2.3%, and ads related explicitly to mammograms received 119,061 impressions and 2,160 clicks, for a CTR of 1.8%. When ads mentioned free or low cost screening, out of 54,409 impressions there were 2,495 clicks for a CTR of 4.6%. In comparison, ads not related to screening, the second most popular group was general breast cancer facts (e.g. "Get the Facts on Breast Cancer") which got 3,994 clicks for 234,004 impressions or a click-through rate of 1.7%. During the campaign, pages related to statistics received the fewest clicks; "breast cancer statistics for your state" got 30 clicks for 52,875 impressions for a click-through rate of 0.057%; "breast cancer diagnosis incidence" got 305 clicks for 37,023 impressions for a click-through rate of 0.82%; "breast cancer trends" got 19 clicks for 62,042 impressions for a click-through rate of 0.031%; "breast cancer risk by age" got 310 clicks for 117,175 impressions for a click-through rate of 0.26%; and "breast cancer statistics for men" got 8 clicks for 6,251 impressions for a clickthrough rate of 0.13% (Appendix II). Similar results were seen for Yahoo! where "free screening," "free mammogram," and the general term "breast cancer" had the highest click-through rates (Appendix III). Clearly, ads related to screening, mammograms, and general facts resulted in a higher click-through rate than ads related to other breast cancer topics during the campaign. As discussed later below, this result was reversed after the campaign ended.

To determine whether the campaign brought an increase in traffic to the breast cancer Web site compared to normal traffic, IVI conducted an analysis using Omniture SiteCatalyst reporting to compare the 6 week campaign period, 1 October to 11 November 2006, to the 6 week period immediately after the campaign, 12 November to 23 December 2006 (Tables III & V). It was not possible to do a comparison to the time period prior to the campaign because the Breast Cancer Web site was new as of the start of the campaign. Greater depth of analysis with Omniture will be possible for future campaigns when certain Omniture tracking code is implemented on the breast cancer Web site; such analysis might reveal specific Web site navigation patterns for visitors who had searched on individual keywords.

Omniture reports gave total page visits to the five campaign destination Web pages during the campaign and for the following 6 week period. Reports from Google, Yahoo! and WebMD provided the total number of click-throughs to the destination Web pages during the campaign. Strikingly, 51.6% of the visitors to the screening for breast cancer Web page during the campaign arrived there as a result of clicking on a text or banner ad: 11,179 click-throughs out of 21,659 total page visits. The breast cancer statistics page also saw a significant 36.4% of visitors due to click-throughs on text ads: 4,964 click-throughs out of 13,639 total page visits. Click-through visitors to the risk of cancer by age Web page represented 11.1% of total visitors: 316 click-throughs out of 2,856 total visitors. Traffic to the remaining two destination Web pages was not significantly impacted by the campaign: 0.9% and 1.6% of visitors were click throughs for the race and ethnicity statistics and state statistics Web pages. (Table III).

During the campaign, search engines accounted for approximately 55% of the Web traffic to the five campaign pages, while 30.3% came from clicks from other Web pages both on the CDC Breast Cancer site and on other sites (Table V). Of the referring Web sites, while Google and Yahoo! accounted for the vast majority of referrals, referrals also came from approximately 50 other sites such as about.com, aol.com, msn.com, webmd.com, ask.com, gsa.gov, nih.gov, etc. In the 6-week period after the campaign, 61.2% of the Web traffic came from search engines and 14.8% came from links from other pages (Table V).

One of the campaign goals was to steer visitors to information on how to get screened for breast cancer. By far, the largest numbers of visitors to the breast cancer Web site were brought in by the advertisement for "free mammograms" which brought visitors to the Breast Cancer Screening page, the most heavily viewed page on the breast cancer Web site during the campaign. During the campaign 2,793 visitors (15.2%) to the "Screening for Breast Cancer" page clicked on the link to "call your local program" and this was the most frequently clicked link on the screening page. In the 6 weeks after the campaign, the number of visitors to the screening page who clicked on the link to "call your local program" fell to 90 (4.3%) and this became the seventh most frequently clicked link on the screening page.

Notably, overall visits from individuals who typed or bookmarked the Breast Cancer site pages and were returning increased from 14.7% during the campaign to 24.0% after the campaign, suggesting that visitors during the campaign may have returned after the campaign ended for additional information (Table V).

During the 6-week follow-up period, the "Breast Cancer Statistics" page received the highest number of visits, 4,191 visits, which was a 64% decrease from the 13,639 visits during the campaign. The "Screening for Breast Cancer" page received 2,500 visits during the 6-week follow-up period, which was a decline of 88% from the 21,659 visits during the campaign (Table III). Thus, the statistics Web page retained considerably more traffic after the campaign ended than did the breast cancer screening Web page. Visitors with an immediate need to get information on screening may have satisfied that need with their first visit, whereas visitors with an interest in statistics may have had more long-term needs. Clearly the campaign succeeded in bringing in large numbers of visitors who were interested in breast cancer screening during the campaign.

## Conclusions

During the 6 weeks of the Breast Cancer Web site marketing campaign, the target pages received significantly more page views than during the 6 weeks after the campaign (see Tables III & V). This is surmised to be due to three reasons: (1) the Breast Cancer keyword campaign brought a large number of viewers to the Breast Cancer Web site; (2) the Breast Cancer keyword campaign took place during October, which was officially designated Breast Cancer Awareness Month, so that many more people were looking for breast cancer information than normal; (3) the 6 week period after the campaign included the Thanksgiving holiday and the days immediately preceding Christmas, two time periods when people may search less for health information.

We note that keyword marketing, which provides links for people who are specifically looking for Web pages related to the marketing campaign, such as on Google or Yahoo!, is different from the pushed content of a randomly appearing banner ad, such as on WebMD and its partner sites. The lower click-through rate for the banner ads than for the text ads may be explained by this point. Individuals viewing ads on Google and Yahoo! are viewing ads placed on the Web page in response to a search for a specific related term. Viewers of ads on WebMD are viewing ads which, although health-related, may not be as closely related to the viewers' needs of the moment. The higher click-through rate for the banner ad on the main WebMD site than for the external, or partner, sites (see Table II), may be explainable by the fact that, according to WebMD publicity materials, although 70% of WebMD users are female and 72% of them are between the ages of 25 and 54 years and thus are in the range for receiving a mammogram reminder message, the WebMD users also have a median household income of approximately \$60,000 and, thus, may already be aware of the need for regular breast screening. Users on the external/partner sites most likely skew towards a more typical Internet user and thus include more individuals with lower incomes and more need for health messaging.

On Google and Yahoo! the campaign brought in large numbers of users who were motivated to learn about breast cancer. After the campaign about 24% of the visitors who previously viewed the breast cancer Web site had bookmarked the site and returned for additional information.

The campaign made a significant contribution to steering visitors to resources for obtaining mammograms, a goal of the campaign. One indicator of the success of the campaign is the very large number of visitors to the screening for breast cancer page during the campaign who clicked on the link to find their local program for obtaining a free or low-cost mammogram compared to the number who clicked on the link after the campaign ended. Note that the link to find a local program also includes a toll-free phone number, so visitors do not necessarily proceed to the find a program Web page.

After the campaign ended, more visitors looking for information about breast cancer statistics returned for additional information than did visitors looking for screening information. We surmise that the arrival of Breast Cancer Month and the publicity it engendered concerning getting screened led women to search for information on screening. The campaign's ads led women to get that information from the CDC's Breast Cancer Web site. Once that need was satisfied and the publicity surrounding Breast Cancer Month ended, visitors were less likely to be looking for screening information as much as other information about breast cancer. Clearly the campaign succeeded in bringing in large numbers of visitors who were interested in breast cancer screening during the campaign.


The ad impressions in themselves are promotional tools that may increase awareness of the breast cancer screening message. Even those people who did not click on the ads may have been influenced to think of screening for themselves and for their loved ones, having seen the message. We are pleased with having been able to expose almost 2 million Internet searchers to important messages about breast cancer, especially the messages that encouraged women to get mammograms.

# **APPENDICES**

## Appendix I. Breast Cancer Web Site Keyword Metatag Content Development

IVI staff developed keyword and title metatag content for the new breast cancer Web site, as per CDC/DCPC request. The following are the steps taken by IVI senior information specialists in performing this task.

1. Reviewed the content of the new breast cancer Web site, assigned a title and keywords for each page based on IVI's expert knowledge of the subject.

The keywords were then refined and expanded using a number of resources as follows.

- 2. Reviewed keyword terms used for the current National Breast and Cervical Cancer Early Detection Program Web site.
- 3. Reviewed CDC Search Terms (Top 1000 queries) for relevant terms.
- 4. Reviewed the results of the analysis of CDC breast cancer search terms for August 2005, as provided by Jeanie Barker.
- 5. Used Google AdWords Keyword Tool to identify useful terms relevant to breast cancer and mammograms (Keyword Variations).
- 6. Used Google AdWords Keyword Tool to identify terms currently used by other organization Web sites such as the American Cancer Society (Site-Related Key).
- 7. Used Yahoo! Overture Keyword Selector Tool to identify useful terms relevant to breast cancer and mammograms.
- 8. Searched through AOL leaked database using two sites (aoldb.unwieldy.net and aolsearchdatabase.com).
- 9. Used Ask.com Sponsored Listings Keyword Tool to identify useful terms relevant to breast cancer and mammograms.
