

**From the American Community Survey: 1999**

**Population and Housing Profile: Pompano Beach city, Florida**

NOTES: The population estimates in this profile are for people living in households and group quarters.

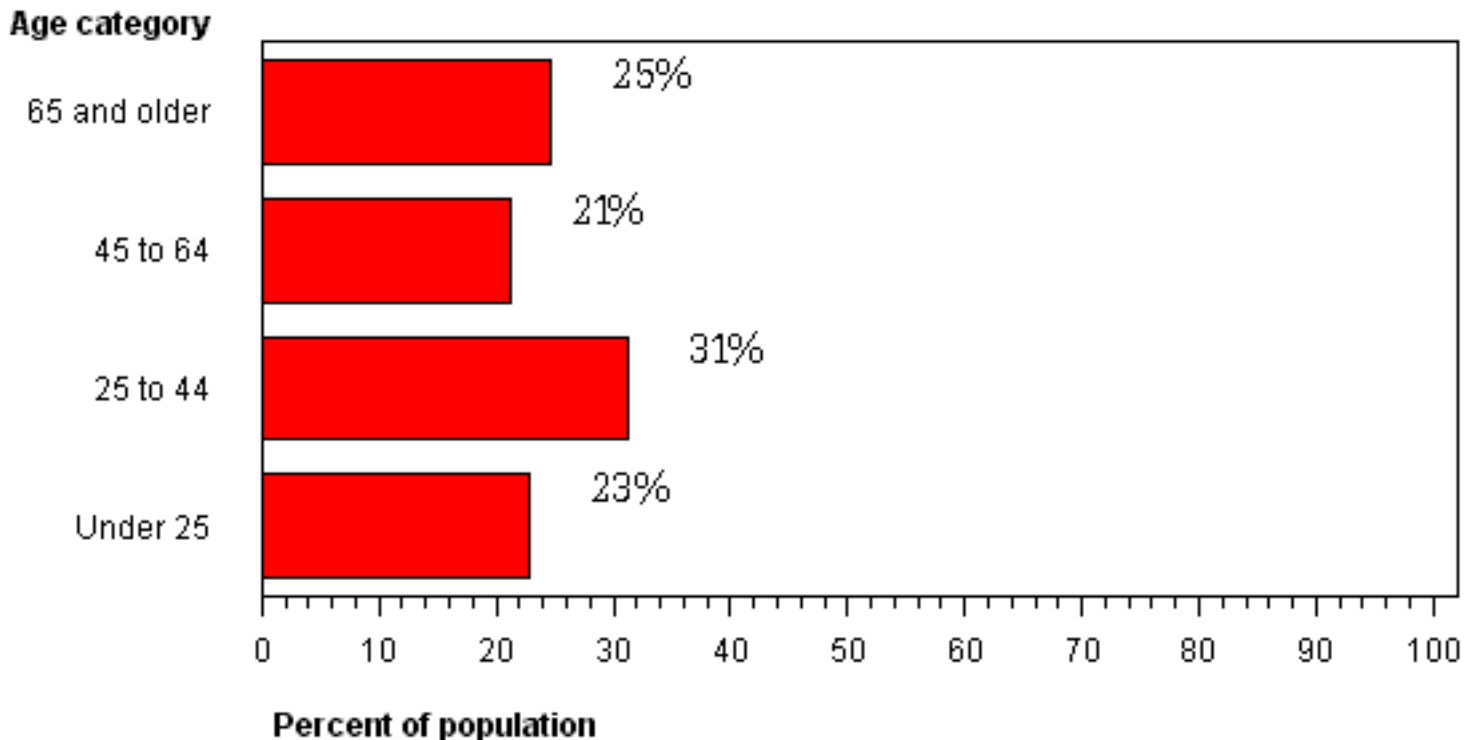
In the narrative profile below, if one sample estimate is larger than another, it does not necessarily mean that the same holds for their true values for the entire population. These estimates are derived from a sample of housing units and measure the true values with a degree of uncertainty. In the Profiles found at [www.census.gov/acs/www/index\\_c.htm](http://www.census.gov/acs/www/index_c.htm), this uncertainty is represented by the 90 percent confidence interval given for each estimate. Caution should be used when comparing data by race from previous years with those for 1999 due to the Census Bureau's implementation of the October 1997 revised standards for data on race and ethnicity. For the 1999 data, respondents may report one or more races and there are seven (American Indian and Alaska Native, Asian, Black or African American, Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander, White, some other race, and two or more races) instead of five racial tabulation categories. The two or more races category includes all respondents who reported more than one race. See the methodology section for more details regarding these changes.

**POPULATION OF Pompano Beach city:** In 1999, Pompano Beach city had a population of 74,353. The median age was 41.9 years. Sixteen percent were under 18 years and 25 percent were 65 or older. There were 51 percent women and 49 percent men.

**The Age Distribution of People in Pompano Beach city, Florida in 1999**



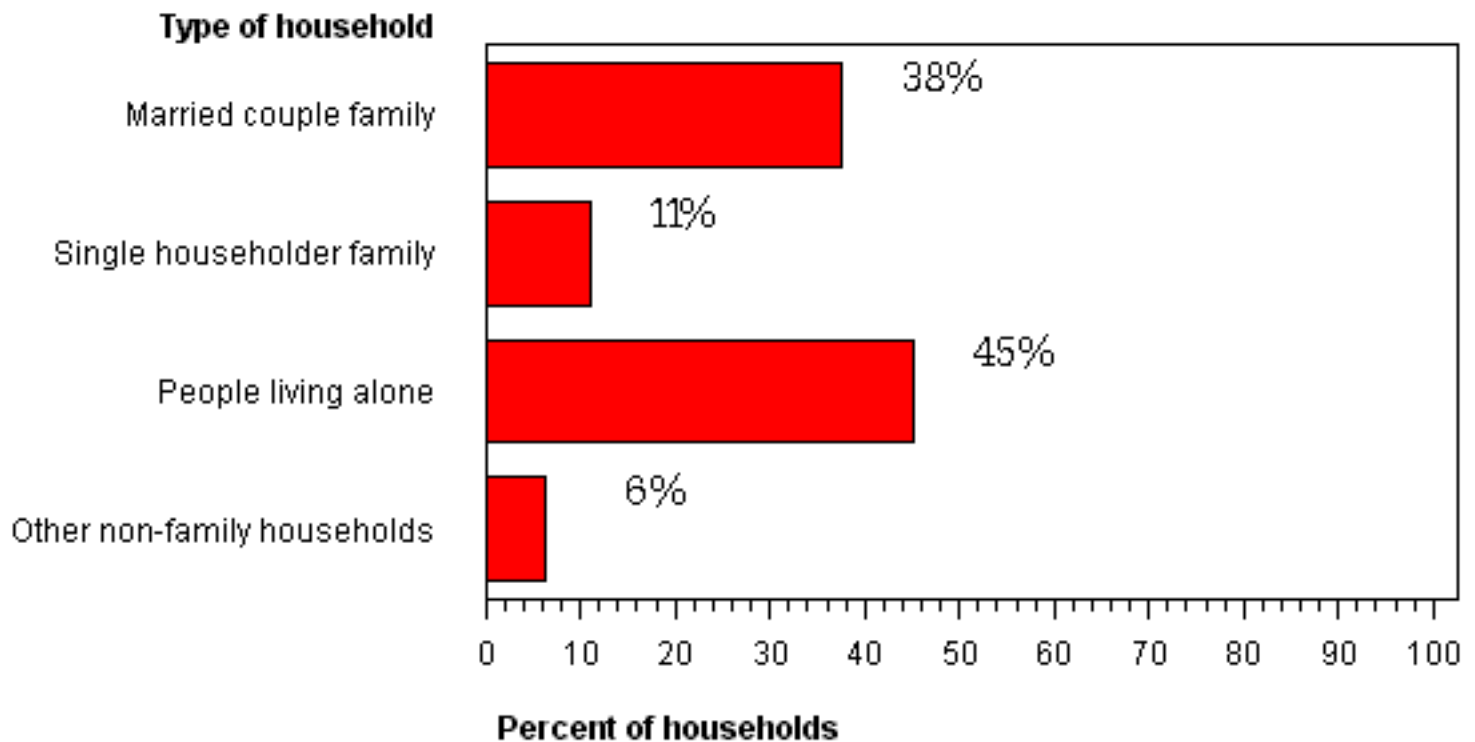

For people reporting one race, 70 percent of the people in Pompano Beach city were White, not of Hispanic origin; 23 percent were Black or African American, less than 0.5 percent were American Indian and Alaska Native, 1 percent were Asian, and less than 0.5 percent were Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander. One percent reported two or more races. Seven percent of the people of Pompano Beach city were of Hispanic origin. People of Hispanic origin may be of any race.

**HOUSEHOLDS AND FAMILIES:** In 1999 there were 37,501 households in Pompano Beach city. The average household size was 1.94 people.

Families made up 49 percent of the households in Pompano Beach city that year. This figure includes both married couple families (38 percent) and other families with no spouse present (11 percent). Non-family households made up 51 percent of all households in Pompano Beach city. Most of the non-family households were people living alone, but some were people living in households maintained by non-relatives.

## The Types of Households in Pompano Beach city, Florida in 1999



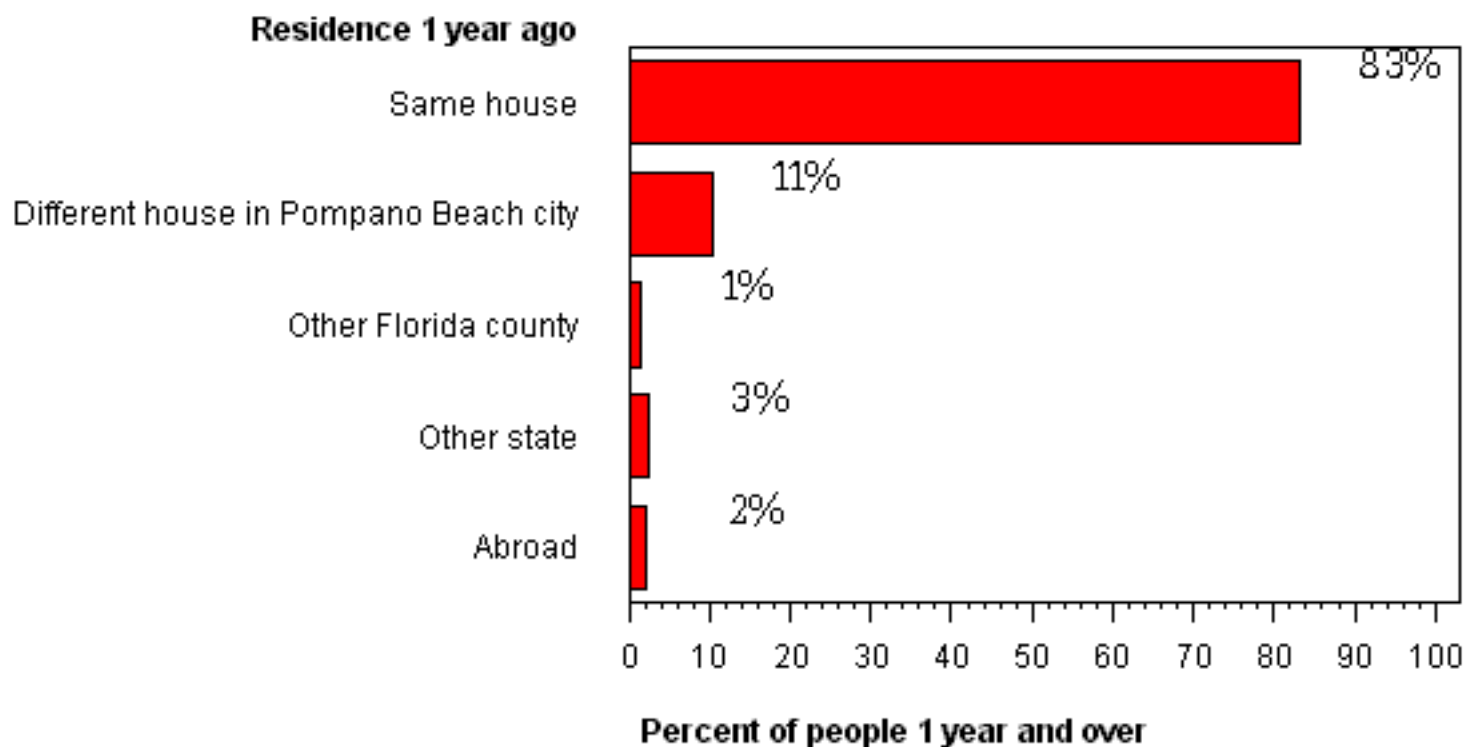

**NATIVITY AND LANGUAGE:** Twenty percent of the people living in Pompano Beach city in 1999 were foreign born. Eighty percent were native born, including 25 percent who were born in the State of Florida.

Among people at least five years old living in Pompano Beach city in 1999, 15,952 spoke a language other than English at home. Of this group, 34 percent spoke Spanish, and 66 percent spoke some other language; 45 percent reported that they did not speak English "very well".

**GEOGRAPHIC MOBILITY:** In 1999, 83 percent of the people one year or older living in Pompano Beach city were living in the same house one year earlier; 11 percent had moved during the past year from another house in the same county, 1 percent from another Florida county, 3 percent from another state, and 2 percent from abroad.

## Geographic Mobility of Residents of Pompano Beach city, Florida in 1999

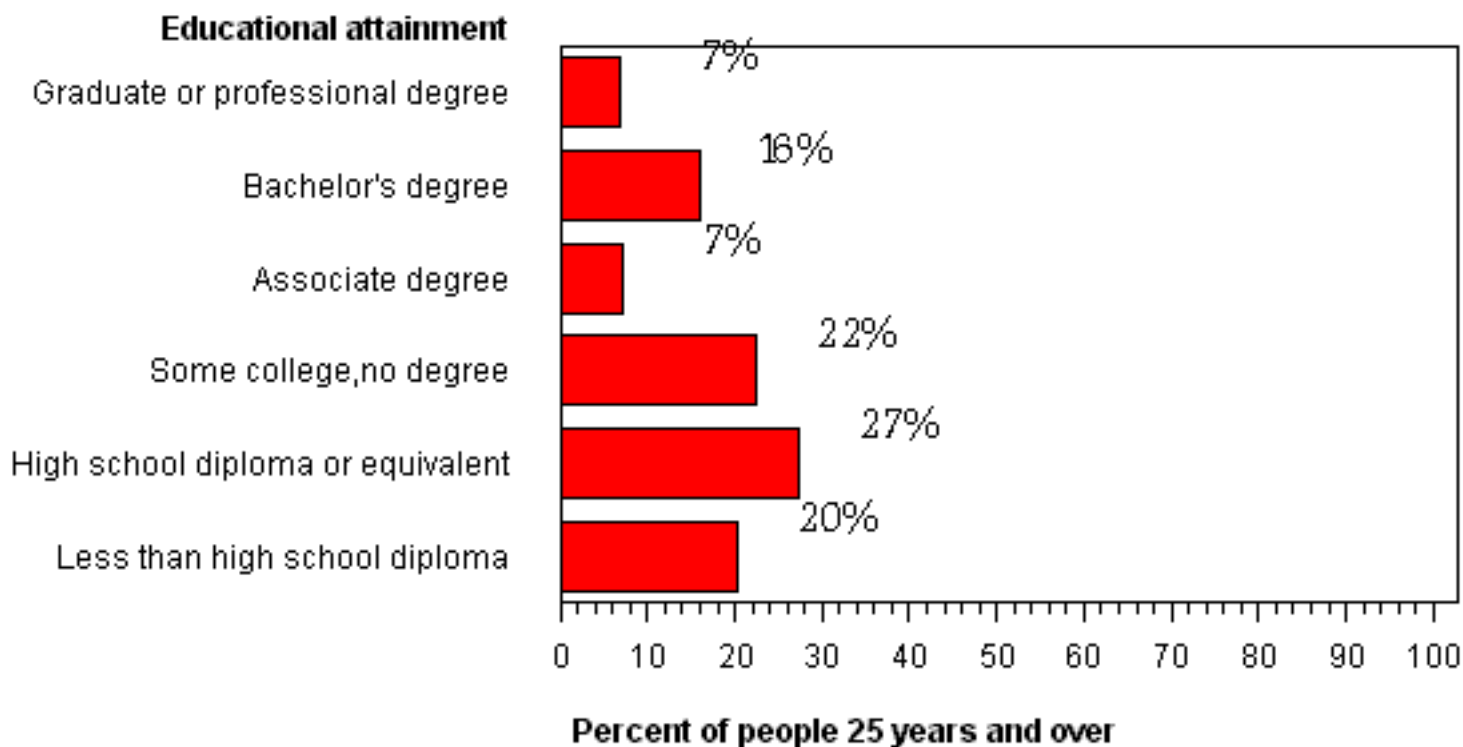

**EDUCATION:** In 1999, 80 percent of people at least 25 years old had at least graduated from high school and 23 percent had a bachelor's degree or higher. Among people 16 to 19 years old, 21 percent were dropouts: They were not enrolled in school and had not graduated from high school.

The total school enrollment in Pompano Beach city was 11,939 in 1999. Preprimary school enrollment was 1,301 and 7,800 children were enrolled in elementary or high school. College enrollment was 2,838.

## The Educational Attainment of People in Pompano Beach city, Florida in 1999



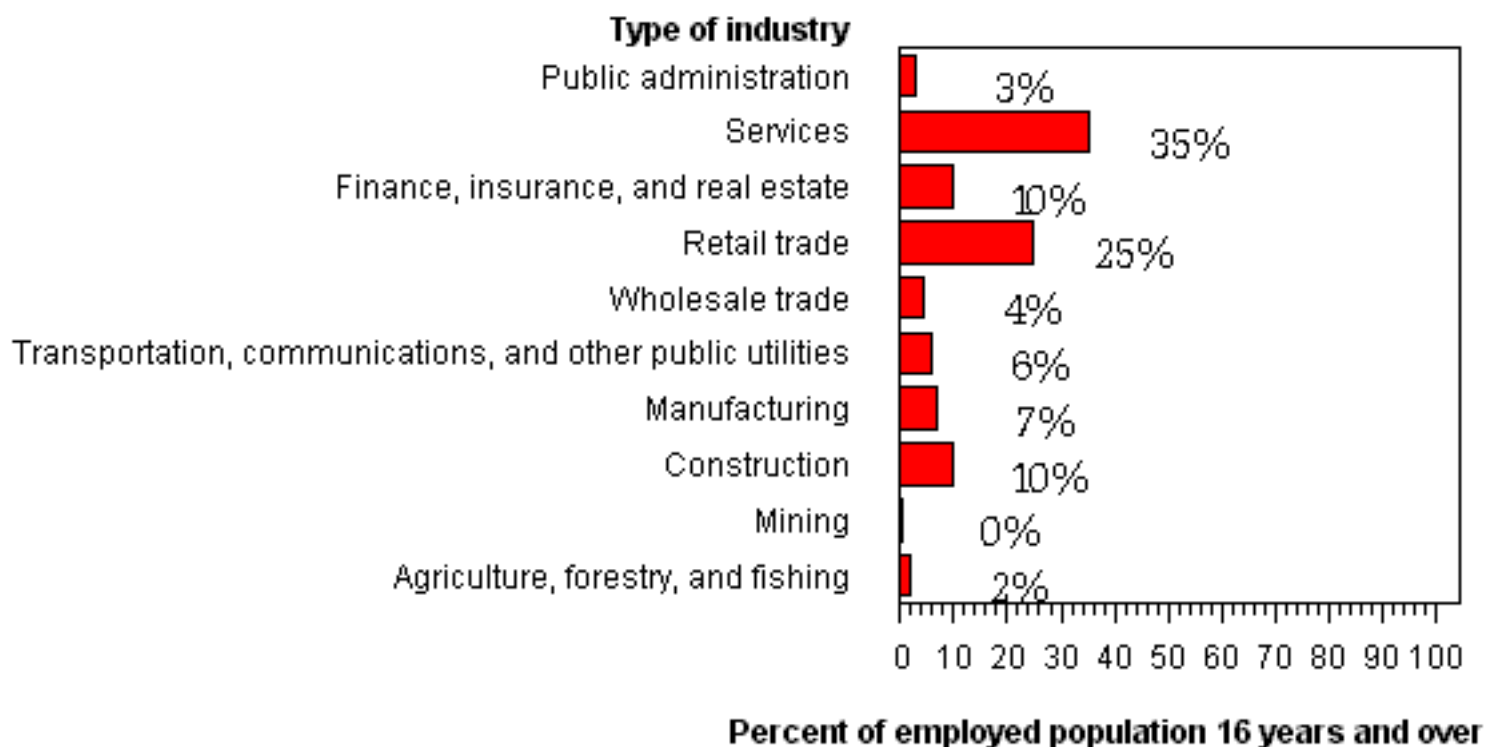

**DISABILITY:** In Pompano Beach city, among people at least five years old in 1999, 17 percent had a disability. The likelihood of having one or more functional limitations varied by age - from 2 percent of people 5 to 20 years old, to 13 percent of people 21 to 64 years old, to 36 percent of those 65 and older.

**INDUSTRIES, OCCUPATIONS AND TYPE OF EMPLOYER:** In 1999, for the employed population 16 and older, the leading industries in Pompano Beach city were Services, 35 percent, and Retail trade, 25 percent.

Among the most common occupations were: Technical, sales, and administrative support occupations, 30 percent; Managerial and professional specialty occupations, 27 percent; Service occupations, 18 percent; Precision production, craft, and repair occupations, 12 percent; and Operators, fabricators, and laborers, 11 percent. Seventy-nine percent of the people in the employed labor force were Private wage and salary workers; 8 percent were Federal, state, or local government workers; and 12 percent were Self-employed.

**TRAVEL TO WORK:** Eighty-one percent of Pompano Beach city workers drove to work alone in 1999 and 9 percent car- or van-pooled. On average it took them 23 minutes to get to work.

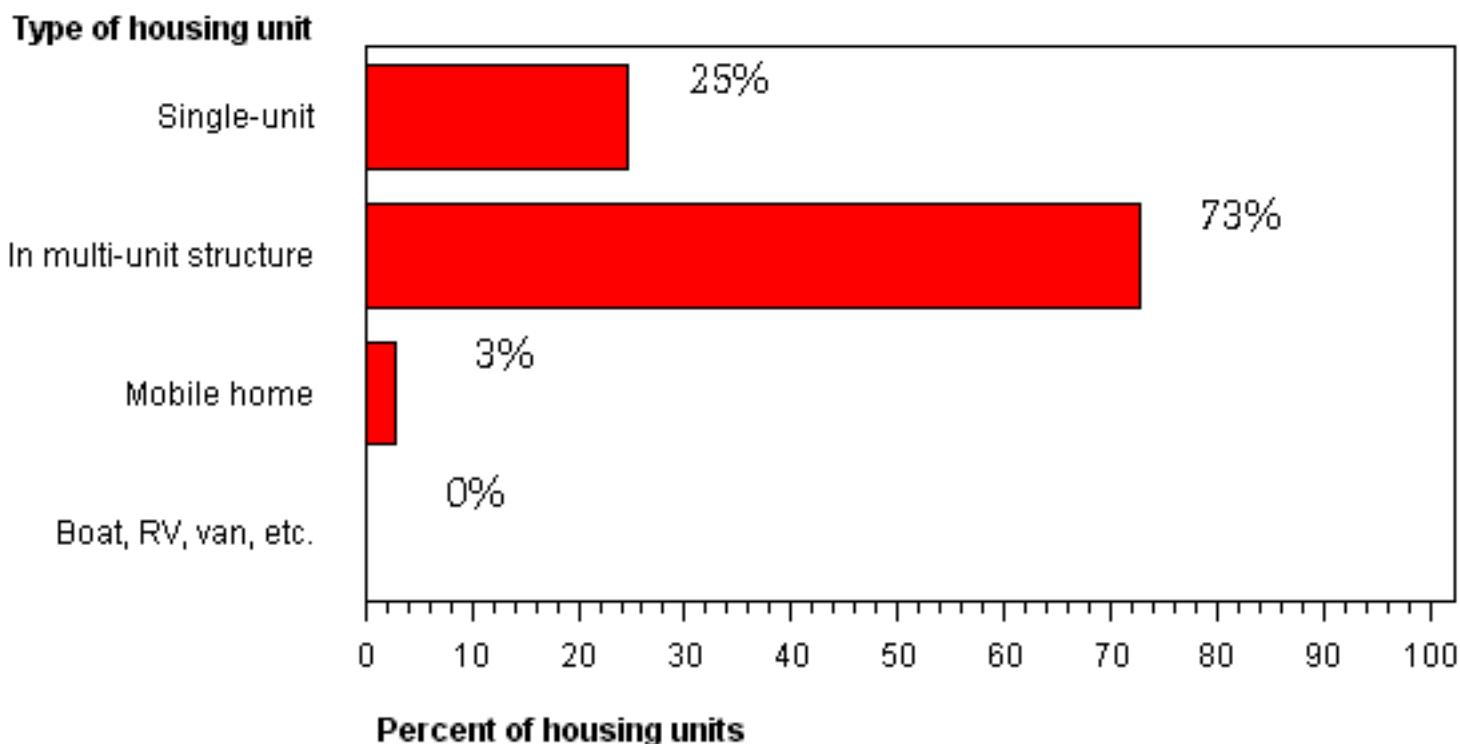
**INCOME:** The median income of households in Pompano Beach city was \$32,550. Seventy-two percent of the households received earnings and 15 percent received retirement income other than Social Security. These income sources are not mutually exclusive; that is, some households received income from more than one source.

**POVERTY AND PARTICIPATION IN GOVERNMENT PROGRAMS:** In 1999, 10 percent of all families had incomes below the poverty level, compared with 24 percent of families with a female householder and no spouse present.

Eleven percent of the households in Pompano Beach city received means-tested public assistance or noncash benefits. Thirty-six percent of the households received Social Security. The average income from Social Security was \$12,047.

**HOUSING CHARACTERISTICS:** In 1999, Pompano Beach city had a total of 49,424 housing units. Housing in Pompano Beach city was spread among 12,182 single-family homes (detached or attached), 1,351 mobile homes, and 35,891 units in multi-unit structures.

## The Types of Housing Units in Pompano Beach city, Florida in 1999



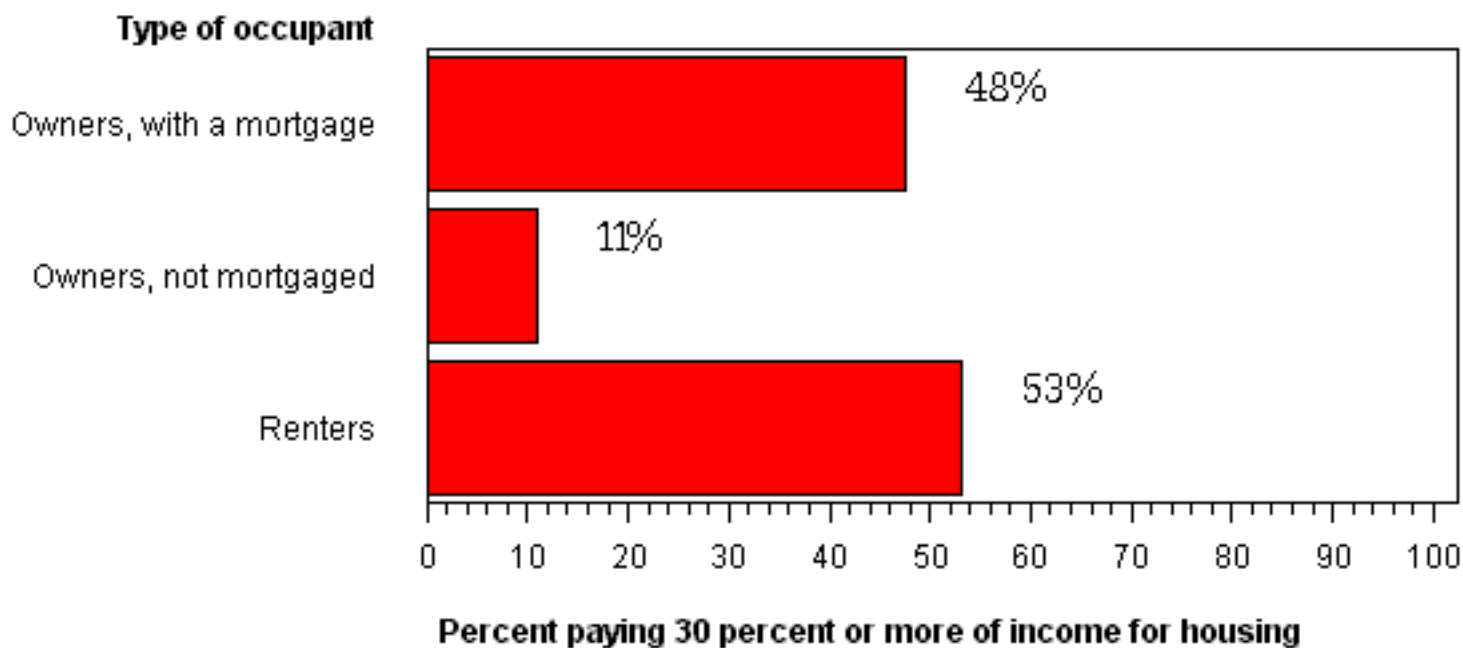

In 1999, 24 percent of the housing units in Pompano Beach city were vacant. Sixty-five percent of the vacant units were for seasonal, recreational, or occasional use. Four percent of the housing units were built since 1990. One hundred percent of Pompano Beach city housing units had complete plumbing and 100 percent had complete kitchen facilities.

**CHARACTERISTICS OF OCCUPANTS:** The occupied units consisted of 22,905 that were owned by residents and 14,596 that were rented. Five percent of the households occupying these units reported not having telephone service in their home and 9 percent did not have access to a car, truck, or van for private use. Twenty-seven percent had two vehicles and another 5 percent had three or more.

**HOUSING COSTS:** Twenty-two percent of owners with mortgages in Pompano Beach city spent less than 20 percent of their household income on housing; 48 percent spent 30 percent or more on housing. Among renters, 23 percent spent less than 20 percent of their household income on rent and 53 percent spent 30 percent or more on rent. The median gross rent was \$675 per month.
