Right to Financial Privacy

Section 21(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 [15 U.S.C. 78u(h)(6)] requires that the Commission "compile an annual tabulation of the occasions on which the Commission used each separate subparagraph or clause of [Section 21(h)(2)] or the provisions of the Right to Financial Privacy Act of 1978 [12 U.S.C. 3401-22 (the RFPA)] to obtain access to financial records of a customer and include it in its annual report to the Congress." During the fiscal year, the Commission made no applications for judicial orders pursuant to Section 21(h)(2).

Corporate Reorganizations

During fiscal 2000, the Commission entered its appearance in 39 new reorganization cases filed under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code involving companies with approximately \$25 billion in assets and 125,000 public investors. Adding these new cases, the Commission was a party in a total of 143 Chapter 11 cases during the year, involving companies with approximately \$57.5 billion in assets and about 575,000 public investors. During the year, 32 cases were concluded through confirmation of a plan, dismissal, or liquidation, leaving 111 cases in which the Commission was a party at year-end.


