

Find Student Loans with LoanLocator.

Now there's a fast and easy way to find out who is servicing a student loan, with the free LoanLocatorssm service from the National Student Loan Clearinghouse. All of the nation's guarantee agencies, large and medium-sized loan holders participate in LoanLocator. Over 35 million borrowers are represented.





Here's how it works:

- Students access a search engine provided on the Clearinghouse Web site at www.nslc.org. They enter their date of birth and Social Security Number to initiate a search to see who holds their loans.
- Results are listed by loan holder, with contact information, both phone and hyperlink — provided for easy follow up.
- Students may also find the guarantor by clicking on the "guarantor" button on the initial results page. The contact information, phone and hyperlink are provided for each guarantor.





LoanLocator features:

- > Available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
- No password required. Students need only enter their SSN and date of birth.
- Students may access LoanLocator as many times as they like.
- > Holder and guarantor contact information is provided.

Student benefits:

- > Fast, easy way to find out who owns their loans
- > Contact information provided for easy follow-up
- Easy way to identify all loan volume when applying for consolidation loans

School benefits:

- ➤ Helps school and student get picture of total borrowing situation, which is helpful for exit counseling
- ➤ Useful in default management prevention
- The Clearinghouse database houses records for over 35 million students. It is a single place for non-commercial, unbiased, comprehensive student loan information.
- > Some student loans may be held by parties that do not participate in this service. A complete LoanLocator participant list is provided.

How to link your school to LoanLocator

We suggest you put the LoanLocator link in your financial aid/loan section of yourWeb site under "To find out who services your student loan, and how to contact them, click here."

FAQs about LoanLocator

- Q: Do participants pay for the LoanLocator service?
- **A:** No, there is no fee charged to schools, lenders, guarantors, servicers, or students. LoanLocator is a free service.
- Q: Is LoanLocator secure?
- **A:** Yes, the information provided through the LoanLocator service is passed through secure socket layer technology for security purposes.
- Q: Will all of a student's loans show up under the LoanLocator search?
- A: LoanLocator pulls FFELP, FDSLP and private loans of Clearinghouse participants. All of the nation's guarantee agencies, large and medium-sized loan holders participate.
- Q: How do I link my school's Web site to the LoanLocator service?
- A: Schools should have their Web masters link their site to: http://www.nslc.org/secure_area/loan_locator.asp.

 In addition, we should suggest that schools place the link in the financial aid/loan section of their Web site with a phrase such as "To find out who services your student loan, and how to contact them, click here."
- Q: What if a school is not a National Student Loan Clearinghouse participant?
- A: A school does not have to be a member of the Clearinghouse to use the LoanLocator service.

Now you can instantly find out who services your student loans with LoanLocator, a free service provided by National Student Loan Clearinghouse. All you need to do is access LoanLocator at www.nslc.org or on your school's Web site. You'll find out who holds your student loans, who guarantees them and who you can call to find out more about your loans. It has the details you need for making loan payments or considering loan consolidation.
