As an member of Bigtube Wireless LLC I must say we have had good success in providing Wireless Internet services in parts of Michigan that had limited or no broadband options available to the local communities. We are now becoming more challanged every day by rough terrain, trees, distances and the rising interferance levels in the current unlicensed bands. We have also been denied tower locations due to restrictions in various towships with constrictive zoning laws and other local laws. If new lower frequency unlicensed bands were to be opened up to the WISP industry we could keep enlarging the areas we can get signal into with many of the exsisting tower locations we already have in place. This service is drasticly needed in many more communities and areas in the country. I also believe that these frequencys could be better used by the WISP industry because of the ability to quickly deploy new equipment into areas that don't support the big numbers of subscribers that the the large providers want.
