

**PATOWMACK CANAL HISTORIC DISTRICT (NPS)**

**Great Falls Park, Great Falls**

This district consists of the remains of an impressively engineered canal built in 1785–1802 to carry boats around the Great Falls of the Potomac River, linking Georgetown (Maryland) with Harpers Ferry (Virginia). George Washington was first president of the company that undertook the enterprise, which, because the Potomac is the boundary between Maryland and Virginia, was a notable early instance of interstate cooperation. The district, with its numerous remains, is preserved and interpreted by the National Park Service.
