Habitation site; storage pits; stone, bone, and shell materials; evidence of microlith industry indicates direct relationship with Cahokia site. Earliest evidence of Mississippi stage of occupation in NE Arkansas. Investigated by Arkansas Archeological Survey 1968, and Arkansas Archeological Survey and National Park Service, 1969. *State*.
