
Dear Mr. Hall:

In accordance with the request of Dr. Infante to Dr. Preuss I am enclosing for the beryllium hearing record a revised list of chronic beryllium cases at Brush Wellman. It was Dr. Infante's assumption that the date of diagnosis shown on the list submitted to the Registry was the date of diagnosis for chronic disease. Actually, for those who had both chronic and acute disease the date shown was the earliest date of illness, normally the acute. To avoid confusion we have only listed chronic cases on the attached list and the date of diagnosis is for the chronic disease.

Also enclosed is a copy of the data requested by Dr. Lloyd of Dr. Preuss on page 2513. Also enclosed is a copy of our rate retention policy statement as requested by Mr. Wright on page 2813, and the analytical results of washing filter bags to determine beryllium control, as requested on page 2806.
