Anniston. **U.S. POST OFFICE**, 1129 Noble St., 1904-1906, James Knox Taylor, architect. Brick faced with white marble, 3 stories, rectangular, balustraded parapet, rusticated 1st story; 3 tall 2nd-story round-arched windows above entrance, separated by Ionic pilasters and surmounted by swags; 1st story used as post office until 1962, then divided into offices; 2nd-story courtroom; 2-story rear addition, 1934. Second Renaissance Revival. Dominant architectural landmark in Anniston. *Federal/GSA*.
