WASHINGTON – Millions of people enjoy spending the summer months doing fun-filled activities, including water skiing, canoeing, sailing, windsurfing, swimming, hiking, nature photography, picnicking, birdwatching, and camping. As summer temperatures continue to rise and Americans have longer days to engage in recreation, the U.S. Government Printing Office is offering for sale several Government publications that focus on national parks and outdoor recreational activities. Whether your family is planning an entire vacation or just a day in the sun, the links below will take you to some of GPO's more popular recreational book titles.

The National Parks: Index 2005-2007, Revised to Include the Actions of the 108th Congress Ending December 31, 2004. Grand Teton: A Guide to Grand Teton National Park. Published by the Department of the Interior, part one is an introduction to the park by a local resident; part two outlines the natural history and geology of the park area; and part three presents reference material and a travel guide to the Grand Teton National Park area (<http://bookstore.gpo.gov/actions/GetPublication?stocknumber=024-005-00903-5>).

Great Smoky Mountains National Park, North Carolina and Tennessee.
