Report Highlights: Total Italian kiwifruit output for the 2002/03 marketing year is forecast at 390,000 tons or 19% more than in 2001/02. This report revises previous expectation of an export decline; current data show Italian kiwi exports remain very large. In 2001/02 exports represented about 76% of domestic output.

SITUATION AND OUTLOOK

GENERAL

Total Italian kiwifruit output for the 2002/03 marketing year is forecast at 390,000 tons or 19% more than in 2001/02. Figures provided by Italy at the IKO (International Kiwi Organization) convention in September were about 20% smaller. This report's production figures are due to an increase in planted area and high average yields, positively affected by heavy rains during summertime. Kiwis are mainly cultivated in Northern and Central Italian regions. Piemonte in Northern Italy and Lazio in Central Italy are the two Italian regions where the increase in kiwi planted area increased (7.4% and 5.8% respectively). These two Italian regions account for 50% of total Italian kiwi planted area.

CONSUMPTION AND PRICES

Kiwi consumption in 2002/03 is forecast to increase due to a large supply. Italian kiwi prices during 2002 were moderately high. They continued to stay high even in October and November 2002 despite a large domestic kiwi supply. In November 2002 Italian kiwi producers received 0.80 Euros/Kg, ten cents above prices from one year earlier, or 0.70 in November 2001. A poor supply of kiwis from New Zealand in October-November 2002 is the major reason for this high level of prices on the Italian Kiwi market. However, prices should decline progressively after Christmas due to a large Italian supply and consumption will increase significantly.

Confectionary industry utilization of kiwis is also increasing in Italy. Kiwis are used mainly in ice-cream and cake preparation.


TRADE

Preliminary data of 2001/02 Italian kiwi exports shows a decline only due a reduced domestic supply. Italian kiwi exports are very large in relationship to total production. In 2001/02 exports represented about 76% of domestic output. In 2002/03 Italian kiwi exports are forecast to significantly increase due to increases in production. Most Italian kiwi exports in 2001/02 were delivered to the European Union. However, Poland became an important market for Italian kiwi exports, with about 12,000 tons. Germany remains the major market for Italian kiwis; in 2001/02 Germany imported 27% of all Italy's kiwi exports.

In 2001/02 new Zealand imports dropped due to a lack in production. Consequently, imports from Chile doubled up to 18,000 tons or 55% of total Italian kiwi imports. New Zealand kiwis are imported before the beginning of the Italian marketing year which begins November 15. Chilean kiwis enter the Italian market at the end of marketing year, in the spring, when the Italian stocks are finished and prices rise.

MARKETING

A recent market study made by University of Bologna compares competitiveness of kiwi industry in several Italian kiwi producing regions and the major European kiwi producing areas. The research focused on production costs and processing costs. According to the table below Aquitaine in France is the highest cost kiwi producing area due mainly to packaging costs. However, Piemonte is the region where farming costs are higher. Macedonia in Greece is the European region with the lowest costs.
