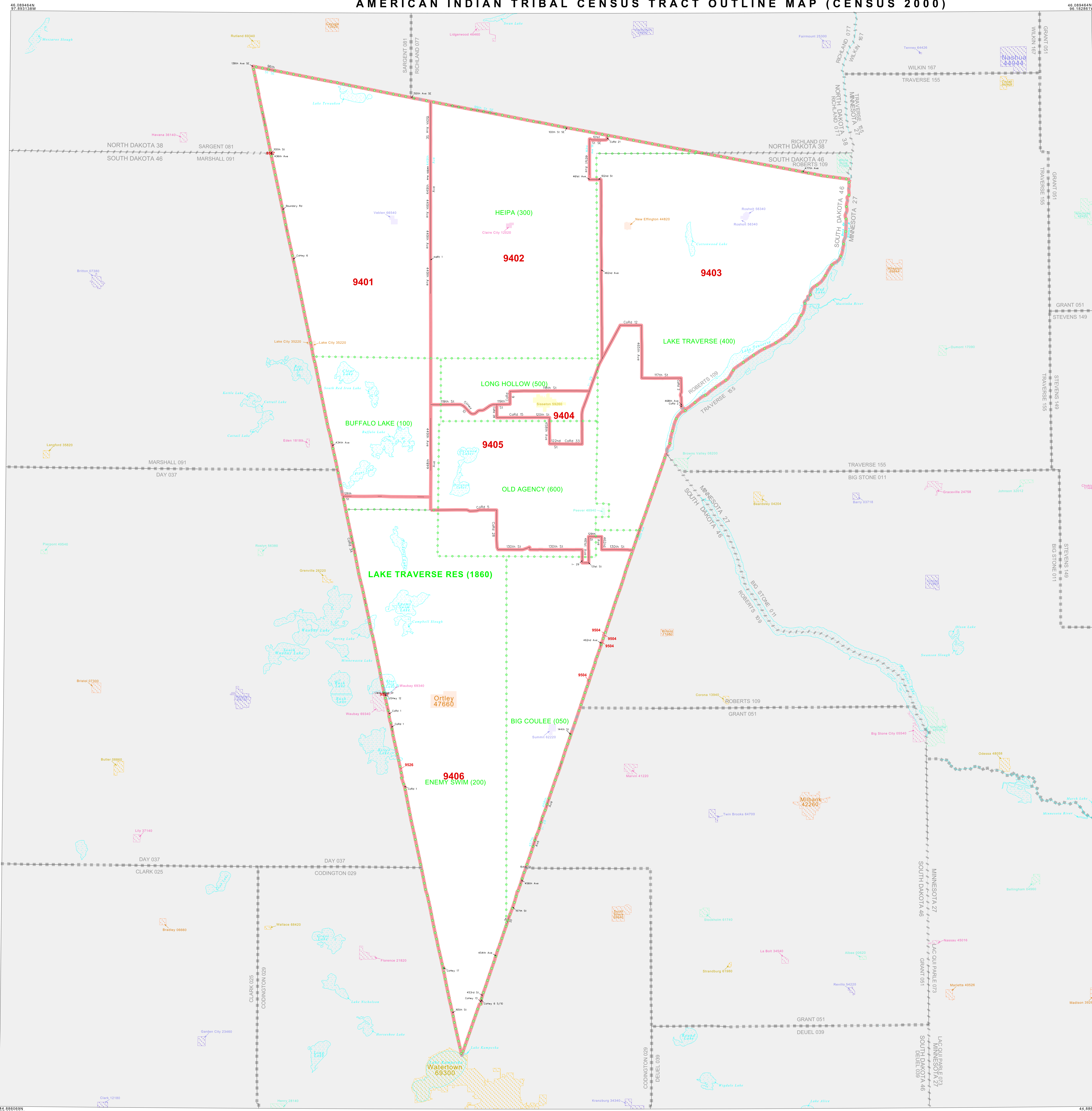


AMERICAN INDIAN TRIBAL CENSUS TRACT OUTLINE MAP (CENSUS 2000)

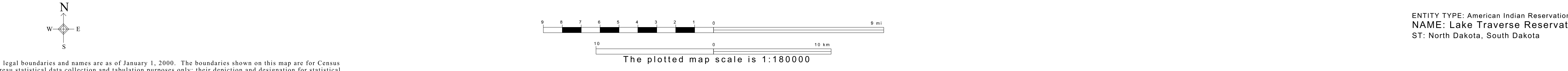
