Record Specifications





The PedNSS transaction (data) file that contributors submit to CDC on a monthly or quarterly basis is comprised of multiple records, which in turn are comprised of multiple data fields. Each record contains information about an individual child. This *PedNSS User's Guide* section describes PedNSS field and record types, minimum field requirements for PedNSS participation, as well as PedNSS record specifications, i.e. the position of fields on the PedNSS record.

PedNSS Field Types

<u>Critical Fields</u>: Fields that must be reported and that will result in records being rejected if they are missing or invalid (mis-coded).

<u>Core Fields</u>: Fields that are considered extremely important for maternal and child monitoring. If missing, they will not affect record acceptance by CDC, but they will result in exclusion from some or all national and state PNSS tables.

<u>Supplemental Fields</u>: Fields that are considered important for maternal and child nutrition monitoring and which states are encouraged to submit. If missing they will not affect record acceptance by CDC, but they will result in exclusion from some national and state PNSS tables.

<u>Contributor Use Fields</u>: Fields that can be used for codes that are unique to and defined by the individual PNSS contributor (i.e., state, U.S. territory, or tribal government) after consultation with CDC.

Minimum Field Requirements for PedNSS Participation

The minimal or vital fields that must be reported in order for CDC to process PedNSS records and generate state tables include State, Substate, Date of Visit, Child's Alphanumeric ID, and Date of Birth. *Plus at least one of the following three themes of health indicators must be reported:*

- Anthropometry Theme: Height—English or Metric, Weight—English or Metric
- Hematology Theme: Hemoglobin or Hematocrit
- Breastfeeding Theme: Currently Breastfed, Ever Breastfed, Length of Time Breastfed

PedNSS Record Types

<u>Screening Records</u>: Records containing information from a clinic visit when the child receives a standard health and nutrition screening or assessment (during which anthropometric, hematologic, and other nutrition-related measures are made and reported). This includes routine child health periodicity visits and WIC certification visits.

<u>Update Visit Records:</u> Records containing information from a clinic visit when some anthropometric *or* hematologic measures are made *or* breastfeeding status is reassessed.

The type of PedNSS record is designated in PedNSS field 6, Record Type.

Code S = Screening Visit
Code U = Update Visit

Additional guidance for contributors of WIC data on preparing the PedNSS transaction file is presented on page 1–6.

PedNSS Record Specifications

This layout specifies the data field positions on the PedNSS record and *partially* explains the field codes (see the next *PedNSS User's Guide* section, "Field Definitions, Codes, and Edits" for complete explanations).

When fields are provided for both metric and English measurements, only one measurement is needed; the other should be left blank. The same is true for hemoglobin and hematocrit measurements; only one is needed. Any field that is never reported by your state, territory, or tribal government (hereafter referred to as "state") may also be left blank.

Preparation of the PedNSS Transaction File

WIC Record Submission to the PedNSS

Contributors submitting WIC data to the PedNSS need to have the ability to distinguish between records that contain standard certification data (Record Type = 'S') from records that contain between-certification data (Record Type = 'U' for update visit), as defined in the PedNSS Field Definitions, Codes, and Edits for field 6, Record Type.

WIC contributors are encouraged to do the following:

- 1. Submit certification (Record Type = 'S') records to the PedNSS.
- 2. Submit between-certification records (Record Type = 'U') to the PedNSS if they can assure that these records strictly contain new data (new height, weight, Hb/Hct, and/or breastfeeding data). Such records should not be submitted if they contain data that have been previously submitted to the PedNSS. These records may contain missing data. For example, they may contain breastfeeding data, but may be missing height, weight, and Hb/Hct data.
- 3. Submit a record(s) with updated breastfeeding data to the PedNSS when infants are between 6 and 12 months of age, to maximize completeness of breastfeeding data for infants up to 6 months of age (Record Type = 'U' unless the record contains all the standard certification data in which case Record Type = 'S').
