

SAFETY HARBOR SITE

Philippe Park, Safety Harbor vicinity

This site dates from the late prehistoric and early historic periods, representing the Gulf Coast Timucuan Indian culture at the time of contact with the Spanish (ca. 1500-1650). With its large platform mound, it is the Safety Harbor type site and may have been the capitol of the Tocobago, a branch of the western Timucua. The site is preserved in Philippe Park, which is open to the public.
