Wednesday, March 23

* Chairman Ruder will testify before the Subcommittee on Telecommunications and Finance of the House Energy and Commerce Committee concerning the October market break. The time and place will be announced.

Thursday, March 24

* Chairman Ruder will testify before the House Commerce, Justice, State, Judiciary and Related Agencies Subcommittee of the Commission on Appropriations at 10:00 a.m. The hearing will be held in Room H-309 of the Capitol building.

TWO APPOINTED TO SENIOR EXECUTIVE SERVICE POSITIONS IN CORPORATION FINANCE

Linda C. Quinn, Director of the Division of Corporation Finance, announced that Howard P. Hodges, Jr. and William E. Morley have been appointed to newly-created Senior Executive Service positions in the Division. Mr. Hodges will serve as the Division's Chief Accountant, and Mr. Morley as the Division's Chief Counsel.

Mr. Hodges has been with the Commission since 1960, serving since 1973 as the Division's Chief Accountant. Prior to that time, he was employed on the accounting staff of the New York office of Price Waterhouse & Co. and as Assistant Comptroller of a natural gas pipeline company. Mr. Hodges is a graduate of the University of North Carolina - Chapel Hill.

Mr. Morley has been on the Division's staff since 1969, serving as Deputy Chief Counsel from 1980 to 1984 and, since that time, as Chief Counsel. He received a B.A. from the University of Maryland in 1964, a M.B.A. from George Washington University in 1966, and a J.D. from George Washington University Law School in 1969.

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

ALAN MICHAEL PIEDMONTE BARRED

The Commission issued an Order Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions against Alan Michael Piedmonte, formerly a registered representative with a registered broker-dealer in its Farmington Hills, Michigan office.

The Order finds that on July 15, 1985, Piedmonte was convicted of a felony based on unauthorized use of client funds in violation of the Michigan Uniform Securities Act. The Order also bars Piedmonte from association with any broker or dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment company, or investment adviser with the right to reapply in eight years. Piedmonte consented, without admitting or denying the Commission's findings, except for findings concerning the fact of his conviction, which were admitted, to the Commission's Order. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

FVL GROWTH FUND, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 5 to request a hearing on an application filed by FVL Growth Fund, Inc. for an order declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-16312 - March 11)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

JERSEY CENTRAL POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

An interim order has been issued authorizing Jersey Central Power & Light Company, subsidiary of General Public Utilities Corporation, to negotiate the terms, conditions, fees, and expenses associated with the issuance and sale, from time to time through December 31, 1988, of first mortgage bonds in an aggregate principal amount of up to \$100 million, pursuant to an exception from competitive bidding. Jurisdiction has been reserved over all matters associated with the issuance and sale of the bonds, pending completion of the record. (Rel. 35-25497 - March 11)

NATIONAL FUEL GAS COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing National Fuel Gas Company, a registered holding company, to purchase up to \$25 million of its issued and outstanding shares of common stock, no par value, in open market transactions from time to time during a two-year period. Shares repurchased, if any, will be held as treasury stock and may be retired from time to time. (Rel. 35-25498 - March 11)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Proposed rule changes have been filed under Rule 19b-4 by: The National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-88-8) that would add Section 68 to its Uniform Practice Code, requiring member firms that are participants in a registered clearing agency for purposes of clearing over-the-counter transactions to subscribe to and reconcile all eligible transactions through the Trade Acceptance and Reconciliation service. (Rel. 34-25437); and The Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-Phlx-88-9) to revise the method of computation of the Value Line Composite Stock Average Index underlying index option contracts to an arithmetic average from a geometric average. (Rel. 34-25442)

Publication of the proposals are expected to be made in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of March 7.

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by: The Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board (SR-MSRB-87-13) to define the "underwriting period" for sole underwritings for purposes of Rule G-32 on disclosures in connection with new issues. (Rel. 34-25438) and The Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-Phlx-87-35) to amend Rule 1014(e) by changing the term underlying "security" to underlying "interest" and by clarifying the meaning of the term "trading session." (Rel. 34-25441)

EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Proposed rule changes filed by the MBS Clearing Corporation have become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934: (SR-MBS-88-4) to add another group of GNMA securities to those eligible for conversion to book-entry form at the MBSCC depository and subject to the depository's physical withdrawal procedures. (Rel. 34-25439); and (SR-MBS-88-5) to extend its procedures for the physical withdrawal of securities from the MBSCC Depository for an additional 60 days. (Rel. 34-25440)

TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

CHEMICAL NEW YORK CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 4 to request a hearing on an application by Chemical New York Corporation, a Delaware corporation, under Section 310(b)(1) (ii) of the Trust Indenture Act of 1939. The application declares that the trusteeship of Citibank N.A. under two Chemical indenture is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary in the public interest or for the protection of investors to disgualify Citibank from acting as trustee under each such indenture. The indentures are dated March 1, 1974 and February 15, 1984, supplemented May 1, 1987, August 14, 1987, and November 6, 1987, and the securities outstanding under them are approximately \$43 million of 8.40% debentures, due 1999, and \$31 million of floating rate notes, due 1996, respectively.
