WIRELESS TELECOMMUNICATIONS BUREAU APPROVES SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN LEAP WIRELESS INTERNATIONAL, INC. AND CAROLINA PCS I LIMITED PARTNERSHIP

Pursuant to Section 4(i) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 154(i), and Section 0.331 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 0.331, the Policy and Rules Branch of the Commercial Wireless Division hereby approves the Settlement Agreement dated November 21, 2000, as amended by the First Amendment to Settlement Agreement dated February 9, 2001 (collectively, Settlement Agreement), between Carolina PCS I Limited Partnership (Carolina PCS) and Leap Wireless International, Inc. (Leap).¹

Pursuant to the Settlement Agreement, Carolina PCS will seek dismissal of its Appeal in *Carolina PCS I Limited Partnership v. FCC*, Case No. 00-1386 (D.C. Cir. filed Aug. 25, 2000),² and will withdraw the following Applications for Review and Petitions to Deny:
