Highlights	Caleb Community Development Corporation (CDC) is offering 12 IDAs for homeownership. The match rate is \$2 to \$1, up to \$1,000 in participant savings over 36 months. In addition to core training, participants can access counseling and credit repair.
Target Population	East Baton Rouge Parish, Louisiana.
Grantee/Collaborative Description	Caleb CDC was founded in 1996 and is a faith-based development agency that additionally provides housing-related services to low-income individuals. The Home Ownership Center in Baton Rouge is providing financial literacy training, homebuyer training, and credit screening. Bank One is holding the reserve account, while Hibernia National Bank is holding participant IDAs. Nonfederal match funds come from such sources as the Baton Rouge Area Foundation and the Foundation for the Mid South.
