WHEREAS, Grantor is a wholly owned Subsidiary of CDS Holding Corp.; .

WHEREAS, Grantor has agreed to grant a first priority security interest in substantially all the assets of Grantor to secure the payment of all amounts owing under the Revolving Credit Agreement, dated as of December 30, 1986 (as amended, supplemented or modified from time to time, the "Credit Agreement"), among CDS Holding Corp., the O.M. 

SECURITYAGREEMENT

SECURITY AGRÉEMENT, dated as of November 23, 1987, made by W. Atlee Burpee Company, a Pennsylvania corporation (the "Debtor") in favor of Bankers Trust Company, a New York banking corporation (the "Secured Party"). Unless otherwise defined herein or in Article XIhereof, all capitalized terms used herein and defined in the Credit Agreement are used herein as therein defined.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Secured Party and the Debtor have entered into the Credit Agreement;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Credit Agreement, the Secured Party has agreed to provide the Debtor, in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth therein, with a working capital line not exceeding the Commitment;

WHEREAS, it is a condition precedent to the incurrence of Advances under the Credit Agreement that the Debtor execute and deliver to the Secured Party this Security Agreement: and

WHEREAS, the Debtor desires to execute this Security Agreement to satisfy the condition described in the preceding paragraph;
