- 2. **CMT Liaison**: Susan R. Morris (smor@loc.gov)
- 3. **Work Product**: Compile/review/disseminate selection criteria for electronic resources to supplement traditional selection criteria (e.g., authorship, content, provenance, accuracy, relevance to institutional mission, and subject matter) used by libraries, archives and museums. Supplemental criteria include: design, use, timeliness, permanence, quality of links to other sites, value-added utility beyond print version, originating domain, downloading capability, uniqueness, reverse links, etc.
- 4. **Points of convergence/dependencies with other action items**: Related to action item 4.4 (Develop specifications for a resource selection, evaluation and user feedback tool. Communicate the specifications to the vendor community and encourage their adoption.), which is on hold until the work for action item 1.3 is completed.
- 5. **Consultants**: A total of seven stakeholders (SCTF) are being chosen (by the Principal Investigator) who have significant knowledge of multifaceted objects including bibliographic, text, physical, courseware, image, data, archival, software, and their combination. Targeted organizations represent the world of libraries, archives, museums, and academe. For example, LC Collections Policy, LC Universal Holdings Group, Global Reference Network, Connexion, ARL, ALCTS TF (CDMS rep.),

- OAI, Infomine, LII, Smithsonian Institution, Getty Art Museum, AMICO, etc.
- 6. **Text for action item**: Unchanged from April 2002 version of Action Plan on LC Bicentennial Conference Web site.
- 7. **Estimate of costs**: Amy Tracy Wells the Principal Investigator will contribute 100 hours of consulting time. Principal Investigator does not anticipate incurring any travel expenses that will need to be reimbursed by the Library of Congress. The consultants (SCTF) who will work with the Principal Investigator will not be compensated by the Library of Congress for their services.
- 8. **Sources of funding**: LC contract funds
- 9. **Task components/deliverables**: A White paper written by SCTF with Amy Tracy Wells assuming lead responsibility. It will include a statement of assumptions, an environmental scan, and pointers to existing selection criteria, preferably including advice as to which sets of criteria are best applied in various settings (academic libraries, archives, museums of different kinds, academe, and instructional objects).
- 10. **Timeline for completion of action item**: Outline of white paper to be submitted by September 1, 2002. All work to be completed by Sept. 30, 2003.
- 11. Communications plan: 1) Quarterly email reports to Susan Morris, LC Cataloging Management Team liaison, due July 1, 2002; October 1, 2002; January 1, 2003; April 1, 2003; July 1, 2003. 2) Announcement in LCCN (LC cataloging e-journal), as well as in a RUSA vehicle to be named by RUSA, that RUSA has accepted Lead role and PI contract has been awarded to Amy Tracy Wells; 3) Brief announcement/summary of progress at Action Plan Forum at ALA, June 16, 10 am-12 noon, Omni Hotel (at CNN), Greenwood Room either Amy Tracy Wells, principal investigator, or Carol Tobin, RUSA president and Leader, to speak; 4) When work is complete, LC will publish and/or distribute the white paper deliverable in a suitable journal or Web site. Principal Investigator will have the right to seek publication of a summary or derivative article in a high-distribution journal or Web site.
