## **2009 TOLERANCE VIDEO COMPETITION**

Discrimination, hatred, and intolerance are at the root of many of the problems we have in the world today. In every country and on every continent, people of all backgrounds still struggle to coexist. It's true that there are many differences between us, including our race, culture, religion, and gender. But do these differences have to divide us?

The American Embassy in Budapest is sponsoring the **2009 Tolerance Video Competition** to highlight the importance of practicing tolerance towards others. High school students in Hungary are invited to submit a short video clip on YouTube that captures the tolerance message in a creative, imaginative, and thought-provoking way. Finalists will be invited to an awards ceremony at the U.S. Embassy in March 2009.

## INSTRUCTIONS

- > Create a YouTube video with an original and creative message about tolerance;
- Videos must not be more than one minute in length;
- Videos can be in English or Hungarian, but words are not required;
- > To be eligible, participants must be enrolled in a Hungarian high school;
- Participants are encouraged to work individually, but team submissions will be accepted. However, only one prize will be awarded for each finalist finishing in 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> place;

  - 4. Click "Add Video" to submit your entry
