

Jewell vicinity. **CHEELY-COLEMAN HOUSE**, S of Jewell oft GA 123 at Ogeechee River, 1820-1825, attributed to John Marler, architect. Frame, clapboarding, flush siding; 2 stories, rectangular, gabled standing seam tin roof, exterior end chimneys, central arched dogtrot, 2-story porch partially in antis, exterior stairway; small porch added, 20th C. Greek Revival elements. Sophisticated example of a dwelling that evolved from basic dogtrot house; home of prominent GA Coleman and Cheely families; headquarters of Maj. Gen. Judson Kilpatrick during Sherman's march through GA 1864. *Private.*
