

Los Angeles. **CATHOLIC-PROTESTANT CHAPELS, VETERANS ADMINISTRATION CENTER**, Eisenhower Ave., 1900, J. Lee Burton, architect. Frame, clapboarding; 1 story, irregular shape, cross-gable roof sections; square towers with pyramidal roofs, one with arcaded drum; arcaded and gabled porches, scalloped brackets under eaves, wooden "corbeled" arcading motif on towers, variety of arched and rectangular windows; 2 connected chapels, one facade rebuilt after 1955 fire. Eclectic. Wooden pastiche of architectural elements, built as chapels for first Veterans Administration center, est. 1888. *Federal/VA*: HABS.
