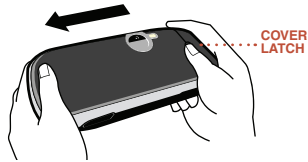

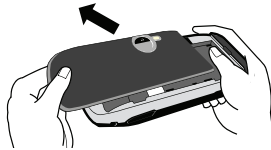
Step 1

Insert the SIM Card

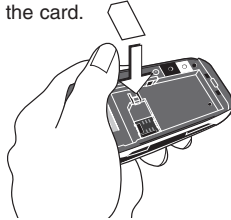
- 1 Remove the back cover.
 - Press the cover latch with your right thumb.
 - Push the cover left to release.



- Lift the cover to remove it.



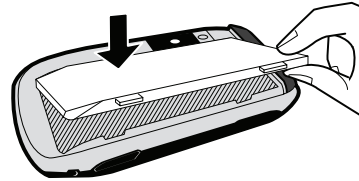
- 2 Insert your SIM card.
 - Gold contacts face down.
 - Two side brackets must be on top of the card.



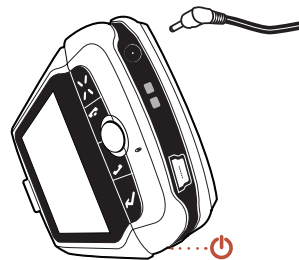
Step 2


Insert the Battery

- 1 Place the battery on top of the SIM card.



- 2 Replace the back cover.
- 3 Plug the battery charger into your device.



- 4 Let your device charge for at least 4 hours!
- 5 Press the Power button .

Register

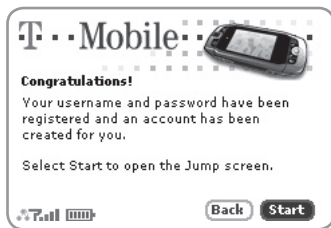
1 Wait for activation.

Getting Help

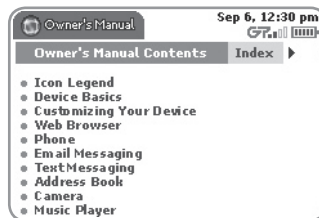
1 Read the Reference Guide.
