

Arlington. **OLD SCHWAMB MILL**, 17 Mill Lane and 29 Lowell St., 1860. Old mill complex including 2 1/2-story frame main building, dry kiln with 60' chimney stack, and a wood storage barn which originally housed a water wheel; contains some antique machinery. Site of 17th C. gristmill adapted for use as spice mill, 1778; purchased 1847 by Charles and Frederick Schwamb and remodeled as a woodworking shop using European techniques in handcrafting picture frames, destroyed by fire and rebuilt, 1860; electrical power added, 1930's. Living woodwork and crafts museum. *Private: G.*
