

## SOURCE CODE ADDENDUM TO ENERGYPLUS<sup>TM</sup> DISTRIBUTION LICENSE A GREEMENT



This Source Code Addendum (the "Addendum") to the EnergyPlus™ Distribution License Agreement (the "Agreement") is entered into by The Regents of the University of California, Department of Energy contract-operators of the Ernest Orlando Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory, 1 Cyclotron Road, Berkeley, CA 94720 ("Berkeley Lab"), and the entity listed below ("Licensee") having its principal place of business at the address below:

Licensee has entered into an EnergyPlus<sup>TM</sup> Distribution License Agreement (the "Agreement") under which Licensee has obtained certain rights to the EnergyPlus<sup>TM</sup> building energy simulation computer program, developed jointly by the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign ("UIUC") and Berkeley Lab under funding from the U.S. Department of Energy. Berkeley Lab has the authority to administer the licensing of EnergyPlus<sup>TM</sup> software for UIUC. Licensee now desires to obtain, and Berkeley Lab is willing to grant, the right to use internally the source code of the specified version of the Software (as defined below) to create derivative works of the Software, pursuant to the terms and conditions of this Addendum. In the event of conflict between the terms of this Addendum and the terms of the Agreement, the terms of this Addendum shall prevail.

The parties now agree as follows:

## 1. LICENSE GRANT AND RESTRICTIONS

- 1.1 <u>Right to Use Source Code</u>. Subject to payment of applicable license fees by Licensee and subject to receipt by Berkeley Lab of any required U.S. Department of Energy approvals, Berkeley Lab hereby grants Licensee, and Licensee hereby accepts, the non-exclusive, paid-up right to install, use, copy, modify, and prepare derivative works of the Software in source code format, subject to the following terms and conditions:
- (a) Licensee shall only use the source code of the Software for its own internal use; and
- (b) Licensee shall not authorize or allow the use by, nor distribute, sublicense, or otherwise transfer to any third party the source code of the Software, or the source code of any derivative work thereof.
- 1.2 <u>Confidentiality</u>. Licensee will take appropriate steps to ensure that the source code of the Software remains confidential and is protected against unauthorized disclosure, use, or release, and will treat it with at least the same level of care as Licensee would use to protect and secure Licensee's own confidential information, but in any event using no less than a reasonable standard of care.
- 1.3 Ownership of Derivative Works. Subject to the underlying copyright in the Software by Berkeley Lab, UIUC, and their licensors pursuant to the Agreement, Licensee retains all title, copyright, and other proprietary interests in derivative works of the Software developed by Licensee and copies thereof and Berkeley Lab does not acquire any rights, express or implied, in such derivative works.

## 2. GENERAL

- 2.1 <u>Rights Granted to Licensee Only</u>. The rights to use the source code of the Software granted to Licensee herein are restricted to Licensee only.
- 2.2 <u>Ratification and Confirmation of Agreement</u>. Except as specifically amended herein, the Agreement is hereby ratified and confirmed.
- 2.3 Entire Agreement. This Addendum, together with the Agreement, constitutes the full, complete, and entire agreement between the parties with respect to the subject matter hereof and supersedes all other prior agreements and understandings between the parties, whether written or oral, relating to the same subject matter. No modification or amendment of this Addendum shall be

effective unless in writing and executed by a duly authorized representative of each party.

2.4 <u>Counterparts</u>. This Addendum may be executed in two counterparts, each of which will be deemed an original, but both of which together constitute one and the same instrument.
