New Mexico State-listed Noxious Weeds

Class A: Class A weeds are species that are not present in New Mexico or have limited distribution; preventing new infestations of these species and eradicating existing infestations is the highest priority. .

- Black henbane (*Hyoscyamus niger*)
- Camelthorn (*Alhagi pseudalhagi*)
- Canada thistle (*Cirsium arvense*)
- Dalmatian toadflax (*Linaria genistifolia* ssp. *dalmatica*)
- Diffuse knapweed (*Centaurea diffusa*)
- Dyer's woad (*Isatis tinctoria*)
- Eurasian watermilfoil (*Myriophyllum spicatum*)
- Hoary cress (*Cardaria draba*)
- Hydrilla (*Hydrilla verticillata*)
- Leafy spurge (*Euphorbia esula*)
- Onionweed (*Asphodelus fistulosus*)
- Perennial pepperweed (*Lepidium latifolium*)
- Purple loosestrife (*Lythrum salicaria*)
- Purple starthistle (*Centaurea calcitrapa*)
- Scotch thistle (*Onopordum acanthium*)
- Spotted knapweed (*Centaurea maculosa*)

Class B: Class B weeds are species that are limited to portions of New Mexico. In areas that are not infested, these species should be treated as Class A weeds. In areas with severe infestations, management plans should be designed to contain the infestation and stop spread.

- Bull thistle (*Cirsium vulgare*)
- Halogeton (*Halogeton glomeratus*)
- Malta starthistle (*Centaurea melitensis*)
- Musk thistle (*Carduus nutans*)
- Russian knapweed (*Acroptilon repens*)

- Teasel (*Dipsacus fullonum*)

Class C: Class C weeds are species that are widespread in New Mexico. Management decisions for these species should be determined at the local level based on feasibility of control and level of infestation. .

- Field bindweed (*Convolvulus arvensis*)
- Jointed goatgrass (*Aegilops cylindrica*)
- Russian olive (*Elaeagnus angustifolia*)
- Saltcedar (*Tamarix* spp.)
- Siberian elm (*Ulmus pumila*)
