#### **New Clients**

Please allow 4-6 weeks for delivery of equipment. All equipment is shipped directly from the manufacturer and requires a substantial amount of time to process and ship. Should you not receive the equipment after six weeks, please contact our Main Office in Tallahassee at 1-800-222-3448(V) or 1-888-447-5620(TTY).

## **Quality Assurance:**

FTRI maintains a quality assurance system to monitor the services, training, and equipment provided by contracted agencies. Questionnaires are sent to a random selection of clients served by each Regional Distribution Center or the FTRI office.

In 2004-2005, approximately sixty-four percent of new clients served were mailed quality assurance surveys. Of the approximately 25,287 questionnaires sent during last fiscal year, FTRI received 7,130 responses for a twenty-eight percent return rate. Ninety-six percent of the responses were positive. All negative responses were addressed directly by FTRI and forwarded to the appropriate RDC for follow-up.

FTRI has redesigned the QA card and has added a section designed for clients to share the program with their friends and family members who may benefit from FTRI services.

# Tina Gabbard Finds a Lifeline in FTRI Equipment

On Sept. 9, 2003, Tina Gabbard and three of her four children were in a catastrophic car accident. Tina and her children were rushed to the hospital. Fortunately, the children sustained minor injuries and were released from the hospital within a few days.

Tina, however, was not so lucky. She had severed her spine at the C/6 vertebrae. Her skull was bolted into a halo, and her family was told there was very little hope for her. The doctors said that if she did survive, she would probably spend the rest of her life in a nursing home.

Tina was in the hospital for less than two months before she was released to a nursing home. Her surgeons had done an excellent job. She could move her shoulders, eat on her own, and even turn her head—all things the doctors had originally predicted would be impossible. Tina then spent 4 months in a nursing home while the Florida Brain and Spinal Cord Injury Program assisted her parents financially and emotionally in making sure they could meet her needs and bring her home as quickly as possible. Tina's family and friends stayed with her throughout these months, never even leaving her side during the evenings. Finally after months of recovery, Tina was ready to go home. She was brought to her parents house where they had added on an apartment for her and installed both an elevator and handicapped equipped showers.

One afternoon Tina had just come upstairs, and happened to see the FTRI commercial on the television. She called for her mother to write down the 800 number. Several days later they called the main office in Tallahassee and spoke with Myrtle Hoffman. "Myrtle

was so compassionate and immediately got the ball rolling," said Tina's mother. Due to Tina's injury, the surgeries that followed, and muscle deterioration, Tina

was unable to project her voice. This Speech Impairment qualified her for a specialized telephone from FTRI.

In the past, Tina's parents had bought her several different



speaker phones in an attempt to help her use the phone hands free. However, her voice projection was too low and the speaker phones could not pick up her soft voice. Myrtle was able to find the perfect phone for Tina. The RC 200 is a speaker phone that is voice activated, uses a remote control (that Tina could wear around her neck) to scan and dial stored phone numbers, and has ear phones and a headset to speak privately when needed. FTRI's equipment made it possible for Tina to make and receive calls, and more importantly to stay connected with her children.

Tina will remain a quadriplegic, but this doesn't stop her from being a wonderful mother who is grateful to be alive and watch her children grow. She feels so blessed. She is especially grateful for the FTRI commercial. Although she has not seen the commercial since, she considers that to be just one of the many miracles she has experienced over the last two years. FTRI staff has kept up with Tina through emails and phone calls, and feels honored to have been a part of helping her to continue to achieve her freedom and independence.

### From the Office

# **Message from the Executive Director**



During fiscal year 2004 / 2005, FTRI served 39,296 new clients with the total number of services provided being 65,546. New clients have increased over the previous year 19.18%, and the total amount of equipment distributed was 76,197.

Since FTRI's inception, over 330,000 Floridians have received a specialized telephone. Maintenance services remain a vital part of the

overall services provided by FTRI.

Outreach continues to play a major role creating awareness statewide. During FY 2004 / 2005, FTRI, in conjunction with the Regional Distribution Centers (RDCs), conducted 2,286 outreach activities all over the state. This averages to 190.5 outreach activities per month, up from 100 per month the prior year.

FTRI continues to benefit from its contractual relationship with the RDCs throughout the state. Some of these RDCs are known as Deaf Service Centers, Centers for Independent Living, or Speech & Hearing Centers. Our contractual relationship is for specific services related directly to the specialized equipment program and is separate from any other services provided by these agencies. We welcome any feedback from you regarding FTRI services received from these agencies. A listing of the RDCs and their phone numbers is in the adjacent column.

Florida businesses continue to sign-up as partners through the Florida Relay outreach campaign with more than 1,000 new businesses participating this year. Information about both Florida Relay and FTRI Equipment Distribution Program (EDP) has been made available to over 62,450 employees. Equally important, FTRI developed unique partnerships with numerous organizations and state agencies who assisted with promoting FTRI program services as a "value added" service to their particular program. Partnerships such as these prove to be a winning situation for everyone.
