

ARIZONA (NPS)

Off Ford Island, Pearl Harbor, Oahu, Honolulu

Launched in 1915, the USS *Arizona* was moored at its Pearl Harbor berth when it was struck and sunk by a Japanese bomb on the morning of December 7, 1941, a day that President Franklin D. Roosevelt declared would "live in infamy." The *Arizona* and a shrine erected between 1961 and 1962 that straddles its submerged remains honor and commemorate the 1,177 members of the U.S. Navy and Marine Corps who perished on the battleship.
