SUBJECT: 2002 NCR SUMMER ENCAMPMENT

- 1. The 2002 North Central Region Summer Encampment will be held at Camp Dodge, Iowa from Six July through Thirteen July. All NCR Seniors and Cadets who are planning on attending this year's encampment are asked to review the enclosed material to ensure applications are received and processed before the registration deadline.
- 2. **The cost of this year's encampment is \$150.00** for cadets and \$100 for seniors, which covers the expense of all meals, lodging, and an Encampment T-Shirts. Cadets must send a check or money order in the amount of \$150.00 with their Application. Applications are to be mailed to the following address.

- 3. Application Procedures and Registration Deadline: Seniors and Cadets must submit a CAP Form 31 Application for Encampment or Special Activity. It is not required to affix a photo to the Form 31, but you MUST specify your t-shirt size in the remarks area. The deadline for applications of cadet general attendance is June 28th. Applications for Cadet Staff and Senior Staff must be received no later than June 21st. Staff applicants please denote what you are applying for and please include a resume of relevant CAP experience. All application packages must include:
 - a. Completed CAP Form 31 Application for encampment or Special Activity.
 - b. Attached Consent Form
 - d. Check of Money Order for full amount payable to North Central Region Encampment.
- 4. **Arrival Times:** Senior and Cadet staff must arrive by no later than 2200 Hours Friday July 5th. Staff members will report in to Building B-56. All encampment general attendance personnel should arrive on Saturday 6 July between 1200 hours and 1500 hours and report to Bldg. B-56. Please plan on entering Camp Dodge through the South Truck Gate on NW 70th Ave. Sleeping accommodations for general attendance will be available for Friday night if traveling with cadet or senior staff.
- 5. **Refunds:** Full fee refunds will be given for cancellations up to July 1st 2002. Beyond July 1 partial refunds will be handled on a case-by-case basis. **No encampment fees will be returned for participants who choose to leave the activity early or are dismissed for cause.**
