USING ADOBE ACROBAT READER

For full instructions on using the Acrobat Reader please see the Acrobat Reader Guide, which can be accessed by selecting the *Help > Reader Guide* menu option.

We recommend that you use the *File > Preferences* menu option to access the General Preferences settings. Set the Default magnification to "Fit Width" and deselect the "Open Cross-Document Links in Same Window" button. This ensures that this Welcome file remains loaded and can be accessed as soon as any opened section is again closed. Also, it is sometimes useful to display the bookmarks or thumbnails, as available; in later versions of Acrobat Reader, the F5 and F6 keys can be used to toggle on/off the bookmarks and thumbnails. Any bookmark (in the left-hand window pane) may have additional sub-headings hidden below it; expand the listing as required – the sub-headings will be listed below and indented to the right of the main heading.

To enable the user to navigate around the documents on this CD-ROM, the Welcome file contains both bookmarks and active links (coloured blue), which provide direct access to the contents list for the appropriate manual or to a particular section within one of the manuals.

When viewing a section, a thumbnail of each of the pages is shown in the left-hand window pane. If a page number is known, for example by reading the section contents list, then scroll down the left-hand pane and click on the thumbnail to display that page on screen.

If more than one section is open, use the Window menu to select the name of the file that you wish to view. If too many files are open, use the Window menu to select the name of one that you wish to close, then close that section by using the *File > Close* menu option.
