## Report Highlights:

U.S. grapefruit captures consumer demand for another year. Sales are expected to reach 210,000 metric tons this year, according to Tokyo traders. Japanese grapefruit remains stable in volume and price. Fresh U.S. orange imports will decline to $\mathbf{1 0 0 , 0 0 0}$ tons this year, despite a good crop, due to higher U.S. prices. The quality of fresh U.S. lemons remains constant and volumes are estimated to reach $\mathbf{7 0 , 0 0 0}$ tons this season.

## U. S. Grapefruit Capture Consumers Again

For the second year in a row, the quality of U.S. grapefruits suited Japanese consumers and attracted traders. The 2001/02 crop of U.S. grapefruit has an excellent taste with well balanced sweetness and acidity and is selling well at Japan's supermarkets and retail stores, according to Tokyo traders. Japanese imports of Florida grapefruit alone for this season will likely reach around 10 million cartons ( 170,000 metric tons), a similar level as last year ( 10.7 million cartons or 181,900 metric tons in the 2000/01 season), according to Japanese traders.

Japanese traders' buying has been cautious throughout the season, resulting in a low level of stocks. Japanese traders learned in the 1999/2000 season that Japanese wholesale prices for grapefruit can become extremely low forcing traders to clear their stocks at big losses. In addition, Japan's sluggish economy made Japanese traders careful for avoiding excess inventory. Current stocks of fresh grapefruit are approximately 1.78 million cartons ( 30,260 metric tons) which represents approximately 3 weeks of national sales.

Japanese citrus market usually switches from domestic products (Mikan and Iyokan) to U.S. citrus products (grapefruit and oranges) in late winter. Good early season sales often lead to a good overall season. This season's early Florida grapefruit impressed Japanese traders and consumers with good, mature fruit taste. Japan's mild winter and relatively high temperatures in the spring also encouraged sales of U.S. citrus products. Florida grapefruit promotions went into a full swing in April at supermarkets nation wide, in cooperation with Florida Department of Citrus (FDOC). Sales are expected to continue until late June.

Wholesale prices are similar to last season's. As of April 24, 2002, white, ruby, and star ruby grapefruit were trading at Tokyo's Ohta Wholesale Market at 3,300 yen (\$25.35) for a carton ( 17 kilograms) for sizes 27 and 32. Size 36 was trading at 3,000 yen ( $\$ 23.05$ ) and sizes 40,48 and 56 ranged from 2,500 to 2,700 yen ( $\$ 19.21$ to $\$ 20.74$ ). Good tasting fruit has boosted this season's retail prices, compared with last season. Tokyo's major supermarkets are selling large sized fruit for 150-180 yen (\$1.15-\$1.38) and medium sized fruit for 80 yen ( $\$ 0.61$ ). Small and medium sized fruit are often sold in bags. Tokyo's supermarkets currently sell a bag of 4 medium sized fruit for 498 yen (\$3.82) and a bag of 5 small sized fruit for 398 yen (\$3.05).

## Israeli Sweetie Sales Drop

Israeli sweetie sold extremely well a few years ago, but they have been increasingly difficult for Japanese traders to market. Prior to the start of the 2001/02 season, Israel expected to sell one million cartons ( 17,000 metric tons) of sweeties in Japan this season; to date, sales of Israeli sweetie have reached only 582,000 cartons ( 9,900 metric tons), however, declining approximately 37 percent from the previous year. Japanese consumers mostly bought Israeli sweeties as a specialty item.

## Imports of Fresh U.S. Orange May Decline to 100,000 Tons

Japanese consumers and traders report that the 2001/02 crop of U.S. fresh oranges are of high quality and flavorful. Tokyo traders report that Japanese imports of U.S. fresh oranges will probably decline this season due to the higher prices. Japanese import prices (CIF) for fresh U.S. oranges in March 2002 were 117.2 yen per kilogram ( $\$ 0.90$ ),
approximately 20 percent higher than the price at the same time last year. This is in part because of the weak yen.
In the first half of the season (October 2001 through March 2002), Japan imported 29,150 metric tons of U.S. fresh oranges (mostly Navel oranges), a 35 percent decline from the same period the previous season. Japanese traders are somewhat optimistic about future trade, and expect a boost in high quality U.S. valencia shipments in the second half of the season. The Japanese market switched from navels to valencia oranges in mid-April. Japan is expecting hot weather this summer, which would also encourage Japanese consumption of fresh oranges.

In early April, California navels were trading at Tokyo's Ohta Wholesale Market at 3,500 yen (\$26.89) for size 72 and 4,000 yen ( $\$ 30.73$ ) for size 88. Prices have declined slightly, however, and as of April 24, California valencia oranges traded at 3,000 yen ( $\$ 23.05$ ) for a carton ( 17 kilograms) for sizes 56,72 and 88 , and 2,800 yen ( $\$ 21.51$ ) for size 113. California valencia oranges are currently sold at 100-128 yen (\$0.76-\$0.98) for a medium sized fruit and 398 yen ( $\$ 3.05$ ) for a bag of six fruit at Tokyo's supermarkets.

## Spanish Orange Not Competitive with U.S. Product

High priced Spanish oranges are not competitive with California products, according to Tokyo traders. Even though traders and consumers appreciated the quality and flavor of the 2001/02 crop of Spanish navels, cost competitive U.S. products limited sales opportunities in Japan, according to Tokyo traders. Japanese CIF prices of Spanish oranges in March 2002 were 141.1 yen ( $\$ 1.08$ ) per kilogram, while California orange prices were 117.2 yen ( $\$ 0.90$ ). Currently, Spanish navels are trading at Tokyo's Ohta Wholesale Market at 3,600-3,800 yen (\$27.66-\$29.19) for a carton ( 17 kilograms) for sizes 42, 50, 56, 66 and 78. Spanish valencias will be marketed in Japan starting in mid-May.

## Fresh Lemon Market Remains Stable for U.S. Product

Japanese imports of U.S. fresh lemons are projected to reach 70,000 metric tons in the 2001/02 season, a slightly higher level than the last season. Shipments from California and Arizona have remained fairly stable this season, reflecting consistent quality. Japanese fresh lemon stocks are fairly stable with 110,000 cartons ( 1,870 metric tons) in the nation's cold storage warehouses. California lemons are trading at Tokyo's Ohta Wholesale Market at 3,500 yen ( $\$ 26.89$ ) for a carton ( 17 kilograms) for sizes $95,115,140$ and 165 . Tokyo supermarkets retail medium sized lemons for around 100 yen ( $\$ 0.76$ ) per fruit or a bag of three lemons for 198 yen (\$1.52).

## Chile Expands Lemon Sales During the Summer Season

This year, according to industry sources, Chile has made its first shipment of lemons in May, earlier than usual, to expand its sales window in Japan. California supplies fresh lemons to the Japanese market year round but according to Japanese traders, the quality of California lemons deteriorates in the summer due to the hot temperatures, reducing shelf-life. Chile has taken advantage of this summer weakness to expand it lemon sales into Japan during the summer season. Chilean lemons are mostly marketed in Japan from July through September when the quality of California lemons is lowest, according to traders.

## Fruit Juice Cocktails, Fad or Trend?

Recently, "chu-hai" cocktails, a fruit based alcoholic beverage, have been selling well at Japan’s "Izakaya" style pubs. Chu-hai cocktails are a Japanese "shochu" spirits mixed with fruit juices, such as grapefruit, orange and lemon. The grapefruit chu-hai cocktail is the most popular and sells well to younger generations at both food service outlets and retail stores. Canned fruit juice cocktails are manufactured by Japan's major beverage companies, including Kirin, Takara, Suntory and Mercian. Canned chu-hai is reasonably priced at almost half the price of Japanese beer. Kirin's chu-hai is retailed at 108 yen $(\$ 0.82)$ for a 350 milliliter can or 185 yen $(\$ 1.42)$ for a 500 milliliter can. Takara, Suntory and Mercian also market chu-hai at similar prices.
