**MEMORANDUM/ORDER**

Before the court is “Defendants’ Motion Pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 12(b)(6) to Dismiss Request for Punitive Damages in Count Four of Plaintiff’s Amended Complaint” (Docket # 7).
