Continue to **Kalambaka** where tonight you will enjoy dinner at your hotel.

### Day 5: Kalambaka - Delphi

Today visit **Delphi** which clings to the side of Mount Parnassus at 2,000 feet. Here you visit **Ancient Delphi** to see the **Sanctuary of Apollo**, the **Doric Temple** and **Theater**. Also visit the **Delphi Museum** before checking into your hotel.
