Market Tone

Export prices for most grades of rice increased slightly in line with the domestic prices, as a result of the active government intervention program. Trade sources reported that many millers were likely to participate in the program, as the regulation was more flexible this year. As of Dec 7, 2003, official sources reported that the government had bought 726,326 tons of paddy, of which 726,077 tons were non-fragrant rice, since Nov 1, 2003. The government could buy only a small amount of fragrant rice, as the intervention prices were reportedly lower than the current market prices.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. The authority to report fragrant rice exports was moved from the Thai Board of Trade to the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards, which does not release official fragrant rice export data. FAS/BKK will report only official export numbers from the Board of Trade for non-fragrant and from the Office of Commodity Standards for fragrant rice when available, but the reader should bear in mind the difference between the data.

Unofficial exports for Dec 1-7, 2003 totaled 86,287 tons, down 57,014 tons from the previous week's total and down 38,317 tons from the four-week moving average of 124,604 tons. Exports during Jan 1- Dec 7, 2003, totaled 4,834,148 tons, compared with 5,542,969 tons (including fragrant rice) during the same period in 2002.

According to the Department of Internal Trade, Ministry of Commerce, total rice exports (including fragrant rice) during Jan 1 – Nov 30, 2003 amounted to 6,740,714 tons, up slightly from 6,678,416 tons in 2002.
