**Internet Information Kiosks** have been installed in our Atrium. They're connected to the internet, and you can access any ".gov" website, and print out the documents you need. For example – you can fill out and print your passport application, register your presence in Germany at <a href="https://www.travel.state.gov">www.travel.state.gov</a>, review possible travel warnings for the countries you're planning to visit, request an absentee ballot, etc.
