Floor Schedule and Procedure

- <u>Suspension Bills:</u> Today, the House will consider several bills on the Suspension calendar. Bills considered on the Suspension calendar are debatable for 40 minutes; may not be amended; and require a two-thirds vote for passage. If a recorded vote is requested, it will be postponed.
 - 1. <u>H.R. 365</u> Methamphetamine Remediation Research Act of 2007 (*Rep. Gordon Science and Technology*)
 - 2. <u>H.Res. 72</u> Recognizing the work and accomplishments of Mr. Britt "Max" Mayfield, Director of the National Hurricane Center's Tropical Prediction Center upon his retirement (*Rep. Mahoney Science and Technology*)
 - 3. <u>H.Res. 99</u> Commending the University of Nebraska-Lincoln volleyball team for winning the NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball Championship (*Rep. Smith (NE) Education and Labor*)
 - 4. <u>H.Res. 120</u> Recognizing the African American spiritual as a national treasure (*Rep. DeLauro Education and Labor*)
 - H.R. 187 To designate the Federal building and United States courthouse and customhouse located at 515 West First Street in Duluth, Minnesota, as the "Gerald W. Heaney Federal Building and United States Courthouse and Customhouse" (Rep. Oberstar – Transportation and Infrastructure)
 - 6. <u>H.R. 238</u> To repeal a prohibition on the use of certain funds for tunneling in certain areas with respect to the Los Angeles to San Fernando Valley Metro Rail project, California (*Rep. Waxman Transportation and Infrastructure*)
 - 7. <u>H.R. 434</u> Short Term Extension of the Small Business Administration as amended by the Senate (*Reps. Chabot, Velazquez Small Business*)

- 8. <u>H.R. 742</u> To amend the Antitrust Modernization Commission Act of 2002, to extend the term of the Antitrust Modernization Commission and to make a technical correction (*Reps. Conyers, Smith (TX) Judiciary*)
- 9. <u>H.Res. 69</u> Recognizing and honoring Benny Parsons and expressing the condolences of the House of Representatives to his family on his death *(Rep. Hayes Oversight and Government Reform)*
- H.Res.____ Congratulating the National Football League champion Indianapolis
 Colts for winning Super Bowl XLI and for bringing the City of Indianapolis and
 the State of Indiana their first Lombardi Trophy (Rep. Carson Oversight and
 Government Reform)
- <u>Postponed Suspension Vote</u>: At some point today, the House will vote on the following suspension bill, which was debated on Tuesday:
 - H.R. 482 American River Pump Station Project Transfer Act of 2007 (Rep. Doolittle – Natural Resources)
