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#### **Report to the Saltonstall-Kennedy Project**

The author and associates spent two weeks traveling to Shanghai, Qingdao, Yantian, Dalian, and Beijing - major coastline cities in northern China. In the course of this journey, we visited dry fish/shellfish plants, import companies, universities, government organizations, supermarkets, and street markets.

#### (1) Brief history of dried seafood in China

As early as 1,000 BC, ancient Chinese started to preserve seafood using natural sunlight drying. This and similar methods of dry preservation were very popular in the Tang Dynasty (AD 600) using methods such as sunlight drying and hot-air drying with supplemental ingredients such as salt, sugar, pepper powder, and other seasonings.

Today, the drying of seafood remains a major preservation method used in coastal cities of China.

#### (2) Current dried seafood industry in China

From our investigation in northern China, including Shanghai, Qingdao, Yantian, Dalian, as well as Beijing, we found that a variety of dried seafood products are well accepted and enjoyed by consumers. Attached to this report is an extensive list of dried seafood

products marketed in China. Items included in this list are major species, product forms, ingredients, drying methods, retail prices, and consumption areas.

The raw material used for the production of dried products range from finfish and shellfish to seaweed; from low-value species, such as pollock, rubberfish and others to high value species, such as pufferfish and abalone. Several imported species, such as salmon, pollock, and croaker are also used to produce dried seafoods. Dry product forms range from traditional whole dried varieties to dry fillets, including those seasoned with a large variety of spices. Product packaging ranges from bulk packing to retail bags, full-color bags, boxes, and giftpacking with inscriptions in both English and Chinese.

Since China has more than a 1,000 year history in the production and consumption of dried seafoods, there can be little doubt that dry seafood will continue to be a major seafood product in China.

#### (3) Current dried seafood markets in China

With the economic growth now ongoing in China, the middle class is emerging from the population of 1.2 billion. Super markets are becoming popular in the big cities such as Shanghai, Beijing, Qingdao, and Dalian. In Shanghai alone, there were over 500 supermarkets in 1996. Economic reform policies have encouraged traditional department stores and side street markets to change their sale strategy and product structure. All varieties of dried seafood products have come to have their own market niches (see attached).

The distribution of dried seafood products in China is similar to the distribution system used in the movement of other seafood items. It is a complicated and overlapping system. The private sector is becoming more and more important in this system (see attached graph).

Bringing Alaska into focus, unfortunately, it is apparent that the price of dried salmon produced in Alaska is too high for the Chinese market (note - this statement may not be true for Korea and Japan). Currently, there is a very limited market for high valued dried seafoods in China.

# (4) Opportunities and constraints for Alaska dried seafood in the Chinese market

There is a tremendous opportunity for the exportation of Alaska dried seafood to China. Similar opportunities exist for the shipment of raw materials from Alaska for the processing of dried products in China. Low valued species such as pink and chum salmon, some flounder species including sole, and underutilized species such as skate, shark, and sea cucumbers as well as certain by-products such as shark fins and skate fins can be used to produce dried products for this market of 1.2 billion people.

Research to be done in the second stage in this proposal includes obtaining samples from this extensive Chinese market and, in turn, creating suitable products for exportation. Since there is existing infrastructure including processing facilities, low-cost labor, and markets, joint ventures between Alaskan producers and Chinese dried seafood plants should be considered in the future.

Several of the constraints that may effect Alaska dried seafood products exported to China include, among others, the following:

- (a) High production costs in Alaska
- (b) Relatively poor infrastructure in China
- (c) Non-efficient distribution system in China
- (d) High import tariff rate in China (45% for imported dry seafoods from USA as of 1997)






## Market Share in China Seafood Industry

## Market Survey in Dalian, Yantai, Qingdao and Beijing, China

After surveying several northern Chinese cities (Dalian, Yantai, Qingdao and Beijing), we conclude that smoked & dried seafood is one of the most popular snack foods in the area. But consumption habits, species and levels of consumption are different among those cities. Beijing and Shanghai are two major markets for high value dried and smoked seafood, while other cities' markets are still growing. The following figures show the basic information on consumption and price levels in those cities.
