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Korea, Republic of Grain and Feed Rice Production Update 2002

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Report Highlights: South Korea's 400,000-ton rice donation to North Korea should be completed in January 2003. 2002 final crop figures indicate an 11 percent reduction from the 2001 crop.

Includes PSD changes: Yes Includes Trade Matrix: No Unscheduled Report Seoul [KS1], KS Post has revised the MY2002 rice production estimate down to 4.93 million metric tons (MMT) from the previous estimate of 5 MMT.

The Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry (MAF) revised the 2002 rice production figure to 4.93 million metric tons (MMT) based on an across-the-nation survey of 9,310 rice producers on November 15. Based on the revised production figure, MY2002 production was 10.7 percent smaller than the 2001 crop. The MAF attributes the reduction to deceased rice acreage and lower yields.

The average yield is estimated at 4.67 MT per hectare (HA), 8.2 percent lower than 2001crop yields. Lower yields were the result of cooler temperatures and lack of sunlight in July and flood damage caused by heavy rains and typhoon Rusa in August in the eastern and southern Korea during grain maturation.

The first shipload of 5,000 MT of rice aid for North Korea left the South Korean port of Mokpo on September 19, 2002. To date, over half of the planned quantity of 400,000 tons has been shipped.

By month, rice aid shipments for September, October and November were, respectively 24,100, 102,100 and 108,800 tons. The balance of the aid (165,000 tons) is expected to be shipped by early January 2003.

The Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry (MAF) released revised estimates of total domestic consumption. In part, consumption changes reflect changes in usage of rice for liquor production. Accordingly, ending stocks have been projected lower for MY 2002.
