Delegate Selection Process

Delegate Selection Process

Approximately 1,200 delegates attended the 2005 White House Conference on Aging. The majority of delegates were selected by the Governors of the 50 states, U.S. Territories, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, and the District of Columbia, Members of the U.S. Congress and the National Congress of American Indians (NCAI).

The balance of the delegates were selected by the WHCoA Policy Committee to ensure that the delegates represented a diverse population as mandated by the Conference's authorizing legislation, the Older Americans Act Amendments of 2000. These "At-Large" delegates represented national aging and other allied organizations, boomers, academic institutions, business and industry, disability, non-profit and veterans' organizations, and others with a stake in the aging of America.

The WHCoA received almost 3,000 high quality at-large delegate applications, making the selection process very difficult, involving weeks of study, discussion and evaluation of each applicant. The Policy Committee sought to achieve the appropriate balance mandated by the statute by selecting delegates to fill gaps that existed after the Governors, Members of Congress, and the NCAI selections were made.

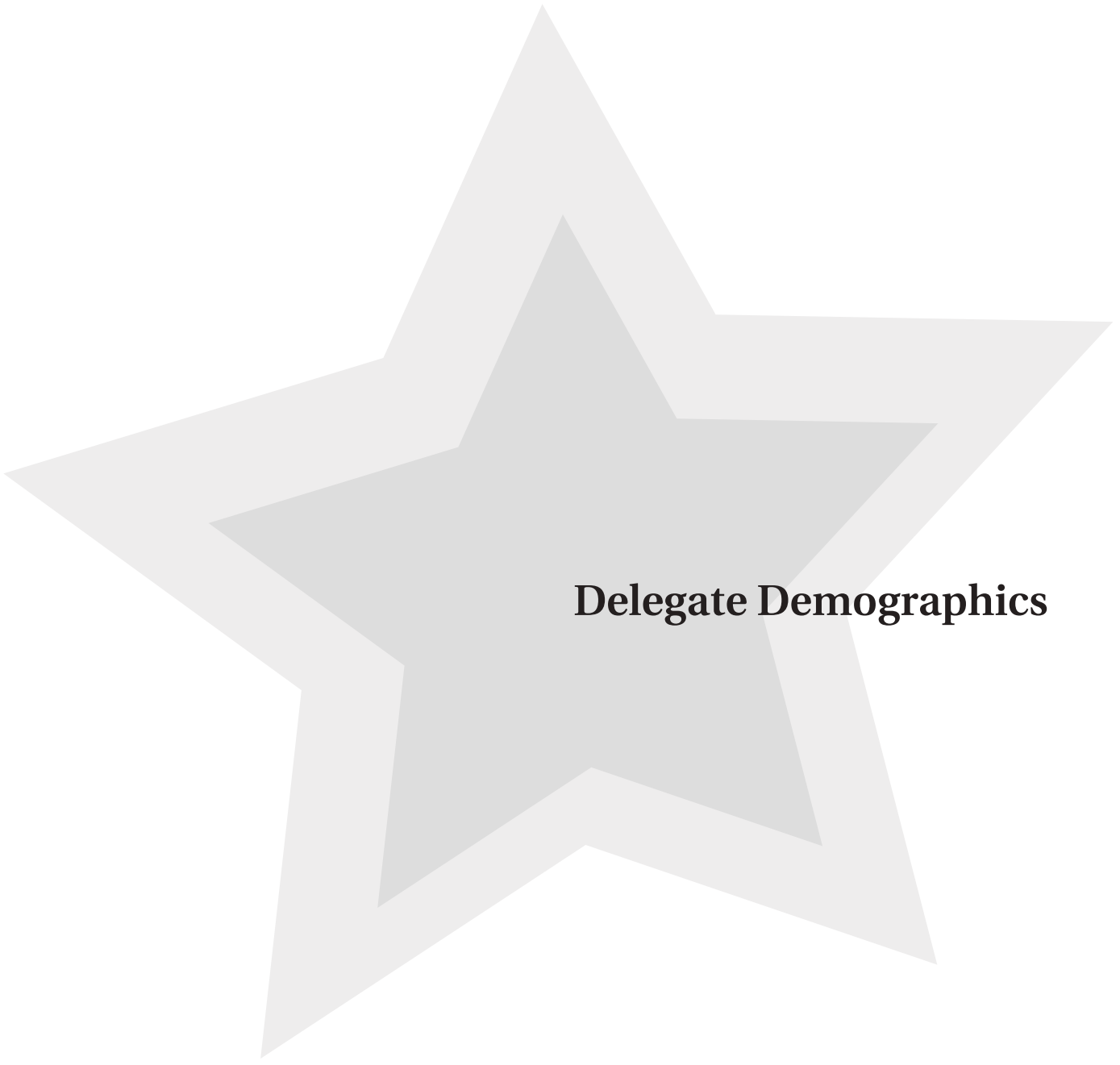
