Report Highlights:

Heavy rains have reduced apple production by 15 percent and table grape production by 22 percent in 2002. Pears were relatively unaffected by this weather, but reductions in production and exports continue as farmers cut back acreage and maintain fewer bearing trees in Greece.

Situation and Outlook

Heavy storms, which prevailed from July to September, have reduced apple production by approximately 15% compared to the 2001 level. This figure is still a preliminary forecast based on Greek Exporters, as the Greek Ministry of Agriculture has not yet announced official fresh apple production data.

Heavy rainstorms also have adversely affected table grapes and a reduction in production is estimated at 22% compared to the 2001 crop. The areas most affected by adverse weather were Crete, Korinthia, and Kavala. Poor weather conditions have badly affected the quality of table grapes and consequently a considerable drop in exports compared to MY 2001/02 is forecast.

According to estimates released by the Ministry of Agriculture, 84,000 MT of table grapes were hit by heavy rainstorms. This amount does not appear in the PSD. Part of this amount was not actually destroyed, but was taken to processing plants by a number of farmers. It is roughly estimated that this was approximately 25,000 MT. This quantity explains the figure cited in the attached PSD under the processing line.

According to exporters, 56,892 MT of table grapes were sold to EU countries and approximately 14,753 MT to third countries. In 2001 the corresponding figures were 86,256 MT for EU countries and 25,283 MT for third countries.

No remarkable changes have been cited in pear production other than those described in the GR 2016 annual report. Farmers are not satisfied with prices received and the pear crop shows a drastic reduction in acreage.

Due to increased domestic production of cocktails and fruit salads and the fact that good quality domestic pears supply is limited, a significant amount of imported pears are utilized by the processing industry.

As cited in our GR2021 spreads between producer prices and wholesale/retail levels in Athens caused

consumers to protest against the high prices of fruit and vegetables. According to cooperatives, there is a difficulty in certifying packaging of fresh products. In Greece there are a number of packing facilities but they do not appear to effectively compete with EU countries. Grading and sorting prior to packing are not consistent. Also, place of origin and pricing have become difficult issues. The Hellenic Fruit Exporters association and the farming cooperatives recently have started discussions in an attempt to reach an agreement concerning quality certification and place of origin of fresh products destined for local and international markets. The purpose of the agreement is to determine pricing objectively so that consumers as well as farmers and traders may benefit.

Recently, according to an announcement made by the Ministry of Agriculture, national criteria for the recognition of farmers' groups in the fresh fruit and vegetables sector are being reviewed. Contemplated changes are for a reduction of the minimum number of members required to form a group and the minimum trade volume required for the constitution of such groups. The easier recognition of farmers' groups will contribute to a better procedure in trading and certifying fresh fruits and vegetables.
