Ash Fork vicinity. **ASH FORK STEEL DAM**, E of Ash Fork off U.S. 66/89, 1897-1898, James Dun and F. H. Bainbridge, engineers. Steel dam, 46' in height and 184' in length, 24 right triangle bents 12'-41' 10" high, 1-beam reinforced by 1/2" x 18" steel plate, transverse diagonal braces connect bents, face composed of curved steel plates which are dished at bottom, 7 expansion joints; reservoir holds 36 million gallons. First large all steel dam in world. *Private*.
